## 2 including JCD leader held for damaging temple

SYLHET, May 10 : A leader of the Jatiyatabdhi Chhatra Dal (JCD) was arrested on charge of causing damage to a temple at Kadamtali of Khadimpura union Friday afternoon. Nilmoni Singh, an advocate was also arrested in the same incident.

They are expected to be produced before the magistrate soon.

## 50 dwellings burnt to ashes



FARIDPUR, May 10 : Fifty dwelling houses were burnt to ashes in a devastating fire that broke out at village Badarshan under Bhanga thana on Friday night.

According to local sources the fire, originating from the house of one Khabir Talukder of the village, spread to the adjoining houses in a few moments. Local People brought the fire under control after fighting for an hour. Besides, ten goats and more than one hundred poultry birds were roasted alive in the fire.

The extent of loss due to the fire was estimated at over Taka fifty lakhs, local people said.

Local MP Dr Kazi Abu Yusuf and TNO visited the place of occurrence. No relief materials were reportedly sent to the fire victims as yet.

## Violent clash leaves four injured

GAIBANDHA, May 10 : Four persons sustained injuries, condition of one is stated to be critical, in a clash over the issue of a disputed piece of land at village Purbo Goyalpara under Palashbari thana recently.

According to a report a long standing quarrel had been continuing between Eakub Ali Mandol and Nuruzzaman Mandol of said village over the possession of a disputed plot.

Centering the issue supporters of Nuruzzaman set fire to the dwelling house of Eakub Ali. On filing allegation Palashbari thana police on May 1 investigated the spot. The situation turned serious on the morning of May 1 supporters of two rival groups armed with deadly weapons attacked each other. There ensued a violent clash. In the clash four persons namely, Rostum Ali, 35, Ali Baksh, 50, Mukta, 22, and Shafiqul, 30, received injuries.

## Housewife burnt alive

SIRAJGANJ, May 10 : A housewife was mysteriously burnt alive at sweeper colony in the town on Thursday night, according to witnesses, reports LAB General Secretary

Aroti Rani, 22, wife of sweeper Ratan, 30 suffered severe burns and was taken to Sirajganj General Hospital where she died on Friday morning.

Relatives of the victim held Ratan responsible for the death while others called it a suicide.

The mini-bus was coming from Pabna to Kushtia. The dacoits barricaded road and stopped the bus and took control of the bus and escaped safely after committing dacoity. A case has been registered with Bheramara police station in this connection.

## Two arrested for violating a girl

RAJSHAHI, May 10 : Boalia thana police arrested two youths Thursday mid-night for violating a girl from the garden of Rajshahi Silk Factory in the city.

Police sources said, three youths violated Mousumi, 16, of village Palsha under Champaawabganj district. Before violation they assured her to take her to her sister's house by giving a lift in rickshaw. When she reached Rajshahi bus terminal by bus from Champaawabganj they forcibly dragged down Mousumi, forced her to climb a rickshaw. They took her to the garden and violated her one after another.

Acting on a tip-off, a team of police from nearby Serusul outpost went to the spot and arrested two culprits, while one of them managed to escape. The victim, Mousumi was sent to safe custody. The arrested are identified as Khokon and Zia of the city. A case was lodged with Boalia police in this connection.

## Loaded wagon sinks at Teestamuk ghat

GAIBANDHA, May 10 : One fertilizer loaded wagon sunk into the river Jamuna and another fell down on board of a tug boat after being derailed from the track at Teestamuk ghat. The ill-fated wagon could not be salvaged till writing of this report.

According to a delayed report, on April 29 a tug boat MV Mirjumalla together with 35 loaded wagons on board of Burge No. 10 anchored at Teestamuk ghat. At mid-night ramp-line locomotive Power No. 3220 started shifting of loaded wagons from the burge. During the shifting all of a sudden two wagons detached from loco-power after snapping its draw-bar. It moved back violently towards the burge. One wagon, No. 53194 loaded with 350 bags of urea fertilizer fell into the river after breaking the clamp block and sunk under 30 feet deep water.

Another wagon, No. 88368 turned turtle on board of the burge after it derailed from the track.

## Accident kills Hindu leader

FARIDPUR, May 10 : The General Secretary of the district unit of Bangladesh Puja Observation Committee, Chandan Datta, 40, was killed in a road accident on May 5.

According to family sources, the accident took place when a speeding truck dashed a taxi. The victim and others were on board the taxi. The accident occurred at the turning point of Banar in Magura. As a result Chandan Datta and the taxi driver were killed on the spot.

Chandan Datta left behind his wife, one son, one daughter and a host of relatives and friends, to mourn his death.

He was cremated at Ambikapur here. Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yusuf MP, local poura chairman Fazlul Kabir Chand, journalists and elite of the town attended his funeral.
