'Cardiac problems can be managed surgically'

Dr Devi Shetty, a leading cardiac surgeon of the sub-continent, yesterday said many cardiac problems could be managed surgically with success rate of 98 to 99 per cent due to present development in tech-nology, reports BSS.

"The expense to manage car-diac problems has now come down to Taka 80,000 to 90,000 from the level of several hundred thousand taka," he

But, Dr Shetty remarked, the present level of expense could be further reduced and treatment could be reached to the poorer people if the richer people come forward with help for development of this specialty in different parts of the country.

Dr Devi Shetty was address-ing a seminar on 'cardiac problems in Bangladesh,' organised by the University of Science and Technology (USTC) in Chittagong yesterday.

National Professor Dr Nurul Islam, founder-president of the USTC hoped that with the help and cooperation of Dr Shetty and his team members, the USTC would be able to make cardiac surgery affordable to the lower income people.

TB claims 80,000 annually

'New strain of TB making treatment difficult'

A new strain of the killer disease tuberculosis (TB), called 'multi-drug resistant tuberculosis,' is making the traditional treatment of the disease difficult, reports UNB.

This was disclosed by Dr Iqbal Hasan Mahmud, a specialist of chest diseases and former superintendent of TB Control Centre, in his book "Multidrug Resistant Tubercu-losis and Its Management." The book was launched at a

press conference in the city yesterday.

"The disease turns into a multidrug resistant one due to non-completion of treatmentcourse by TB patients," Dr Mahmud said, adding that as a result the number of tuberculosis patients is increasing alarmingly.

"There are about 5.7 lakh tuberculosis patients in Bangladesh and about one and a half lakh new patients are being recorded each year," Dr Mahmud said.

He further informed that about 80 thousand people die of the disease every year in the country.

About 50,000 people die of tuberculosis globally every week, he stated, saying that TB and AIDS have close relation to each other. "About one crore people have been affected by the two killer diseases," he said.

Body to formulate new drug policy to be formed soon

The government has taken necessary measures to constitute a high-powered committee to formulate a new drug-policy in the country, Parliament was told yesterday, reports UNB.

Deputy Minister for Health Prof Dr M Aman Ullah said the committee will be formed with officials and personalities of all levels so that the drug policy could be formulated more effec-

It is expected that the task to frame the new policy could be started shortly with the formation of the committee, he replied to a starred question from Haji Mohammad Selim of Awami League.

Responding to another question from Syed Ashraful Islam of the Treasury bench, Prof Aman Ullah said that formulation of a health policy is now under active consideration of the government.

A high-powered committee is working to draft a people-ori-ented and acceptable-to-all health policy, he said adding that the matter is at final stage.

Replying to Harunur Rashid Khan Monno of BNP, the deputy minister informed the House that the government is considering to allow foreign physicians to practice in Bangladesh.
