Press reports denied

0.5 to 4 pc boro crops affected by chita

The government yesterday dismissed the reports published in a section of the press that severe damage was caused to boro crops due to grain sterility (chita) in some parts of the country, reports BSS.

Clarifying the position, the government said the press reports were not based on facts as per the opinion of the inter-departmental experts. It said the actual situation is not at all alarming.

An official handout issued yesterday said following the press reports, the experts of Bangladesh Rice Research Institute (BRRI) and Agriculture Minister Motta Chowdhury himself visited the affected areas of Sherpur, Netrokona, Rangpur, Dinajpur, Gaibandha, Kurigram, Bogra, Lalmonirhat and Brahmanbaria.

They found 0.5 to 4 per cent of boro crops of the areas affected by chita and of them, only 0.3 to 3 per cent damaged by it.

The volume of the affected crops are quite negligible, the experts opined.

They said grain sterility is nothing new in the country, particularly in the areas where winter prolongs upto Chaitra - last month of the Bangla Year.

The experts said such problem was recorded in 110 thanas of 17 districts in 1990-91 and five per cent of the crops were affected, but the production of boro that year was higher than the preceding four years.

Kibria seeks British assistance for dev projects

Finance Minister Shah A M S Kibria has sought British assistance for implementing some development projects in Bangladesh, reports UNB.

Kibria sought the cooperation from Britain during a meeting with Barrie Hudson, leader of the British delegation in the 30th annual meeting of the ADB in Fukuoka yesterday, according to a message received here.

Projects for which assistance were sought included construction of Bhairab Road Bridge on Dhaka-Sylhet Highway, expediting British assistance for efficiency unit in Bangladesh government, expediting assistance for the Privatisation Board, facilitating private sector infrastructure development project and improving English language teaching in Bangladesh.

During the meeting, the Finance Minister also discussed several issues relating to British development assistance and private foreign investment in Bangladesh.

HC directs Pubali Bank to hand over property in Ctg to actual owner

The High Court has directed the Pubali Bank Limited to deliver possession of a property in Chittagong to its actual owner, Lazaf Commercial Corp, within 60 days, reports UNB.

A division bench of the High Court, comprising Justice Muhammad Mozammel Haque and Justice Muhammad Hasan Amin, delivered the judgement recently upon a writ petition filed by Pubali Bank against the government and others.

It said the petitioner Pubali Bank is in illegal possession of the suit property. Failing to hand over possession in due time, Pubali Bank will be evicted by a magistrate with police force.

The court, in its judgement on April 10, observed that the petitioner Pubali Bank is fully aware that Lazaf Commercial Corp is the actual owner and that the suit property is not an abandoned property and the dues of Pubali Bank have already been satisfied.

Barrister M A Tariq appeared for the petitioner while Deputy Attorney General Kaderuddin Ahmed for the government. Barrister Rafiqul Haq, Barrister Rokonuddin Mahmud and Zafarullah Chowdhury appeared for the respondents.

United Insurance Co declares 20pc dividend
