Seven lakh TB patients in N-districts

PABNA, May 13: Incidence of Tuberculosis (TB) has been increasing in the Northern parts of the country with seven lakh cases recorded in the 16 districts, reports UNB.

According to reports avail-able from clinics and hospitals, the number of TB patients has doubled in the last eight years but treatment and medicare facilities has not been extended to cope with the situation.

Out of the 16 districts, only six have got some facilities for tuberculosis patients.

People of the greater districts of Rangpur and Dinajpur have to depend on only one TB hospital located at Tajhat in Rangpur. The other areas have only outdoor treatment facili-

Thana and Union level health centres have no TB treatment facility at all causing difficulties to the poor patients.
