

Eight convicted for robbery in Sylhet

SYLHET, May 13: Eight people were awarded seven years rigorous imprisonment (RI) each with a fine of Tk 500, in default, to suffer another one year RI in a dacoity case, court sources said here Sunday. reports UNB.

The convicted are: Babu, Khokon, Jamaluddin, Golam Hossain, Kamaluddin, Salahuddin, Abdul Mannan and Majnu.

According to the prosecution story, the accused committed a dacoity in the godown of Acme Laboratories Ltd in the town on December 17, 1994 and looted medicine worth about Tk 8,10,193. Later, police arrested them from Moulvi Bazar and filed a case against them.

Additional Sessions and Special Tribunal Judge Sirajul Mawla delivered the judgment after examining the records and witnesses last week.

Another report adds: Police seized 160 sacks of sugar worth about four lakh from a truck, parked near a godown at Kalighat in the town on Wednesday.

Owner of the godown demanded that he bought the sugar auctioned by Hill customs and showed the papers. But police suspected the papers as fake.



Fishermen from nearby villages of Mongla in Sundarbans anchor their boats every morning in the mid-Pashur river in their attempt to fetch as many shrimp fries as possible during the day-long catch. Almost all the fishermen, who number about 4,000, use the fine threaded nylon current nets to trap maximum number of fries which proved to be a very effective method especially in a river like Pashur where current of the river water is very high. In one hand, the fishermen make handsome amount of money selling the fries to the owners of shrimp enclosures while on the other hand, use of current nets is damaging the aquatic ecology here which may take decades to heal. Authority concerned seems to be totally silent regarding the issue.

Seven lakh TB patients in N-districts

PABNA, May 13: Incidence of Tuberculosis (TB) has been increasing in the Northern parts of the country with seven lakh cases recorded in the 16 districts, reports UNB.

According to reports available from clinics and hospitals, the number of TB patients has doubled in the last eight years but treatment and medicare facilities has not been extended to cope with the situation.

Out of the 16 districts, only six have got some facilities for tuberculosis patients.

People of the greater districts of Rangpur and Dinajpur have to depend on only one TB hospital located at Tajhat in Rangpur. The other areas have only outdoor treatment facilities.

Thana and Union level health centres have no TB treatment facility at all causing difficulties to the poor patients.

RUTA urges govt to nab terrorists

RAJSHAHI, May 13: The Rajshahi University Teachers' Association (RUTA) in a meeting on Sunday night expressed its grave concern over the police role regarding arrest of terrorists responsible for the ransacking of the residences of teachers on April 26.

RUTA urged the government to bring the culprits to book immediately. In the other decision RUTA asked the pro-Jamaat teachers to refrain from what it called 'heinous activities' supporting Islamic Chhatra Shibir (ICS) activities in the name of Sachetun Sikkhok Samaj. Regarding the letter of 43 pro-Jamaat and a faction of pro-BNP teachers, RUTA said all the decisions were taken according to the constitution of RUTA.

RUTA also expressed its concern over terrorism at Rajshahi, Dhaka, Chittagong and Islamic University campuses. Meanwhile, the students

who were driven out from Shahid Shamsuddin Hall of Rajshahi University demanded removal of police from the hall and rehabilitation of students.

In a press conference on Sunday night at Rajshahi City Press Club they demanded postponement of all examinations until rehabilitation of the students.

They alleged that forceful removal of the students of Joha Hall without closure of the university or postponement of examinations was inhuman.

A large number of police gheraoed the press club during the press conference for about two hours and manhandled the journalists. All shops surrounding the club were closed. Rajshahi City Press Club President Najib Wadood and general secretary Mohammad Julfikar protested the role of police and termed it as a violation of democratic values and press freedom.

Smuggled Indian tortoise seized in clash with villagers

JHENIDAH, May 13: Smuggled Indian tortoise worth about Taka seven lakh was seized loaded on a truck near Hatgopalpur in Jhenidah sadar thana on the night of May 6, according to police sources.

Police stopped the Dhaka bound truck from Benapole (Dhaka Metro Na-7672) at about 10:00 pm. The tortoise were allegedly smuggled in Bangladesh.

A case was filed with Jhenidah thana in this connection.

RANGPUR, May 13: Seven policemen were injured, two seriously, in an attack by the villagers at Fulkochi village in Mithapukur thana here on Wednesday, reports UNB.

Acting as a tip-off, a contingent of police went to the village and nabbed Shaju, a cowlifter and wanted criminal. While returning to the police station with the arrested cowlifter, local people armed with lethal weapons attacked the police and started beating them indiscriminately. At one stage they snatched away the cowlifter.

One killed in BSF firing near Kushtia border

KUSHTIA, May 13: A Bangladeshi citizen was shot dead when the Indian Border Security Force (BSF) opened fire on late Sunday night near the bordering village of Moham-madpur under Daulatpur thana. witnesses here said on Monday. The victim was identified as Rokman, age about 40 from Ramkrishnapur union of the same thana.

The villagers said, Rokman was a leader of local smugglers. It is assumed that BSF shot at him when Rokman had entered into the Indian territory crossing the Daulatpur border in the dark.

BDR as well as police could not confirm till writing of this report, whether Rokmans body was returned.

Murderer husband commits suicide

SATKHIRA, May 13: A man allegedly committed suicide by taking poison on Tuesday, four days after he killed his wife, reports UNB.

Villagers said Dula Das, of Laskar para in Sadar thana, beat his wife Subhasrani Das to death and hid the body at Dabdhanga bill.

But Dula Das allegedly committed suicide apprehending police arrest when he came to know that police recovered the body of his wife from the bill.

The body was sent to the morgue for autopsy.
