

## Contraband goods worth Tk 15 lakh seized

From Our Correspondent SATKHIRA, May 14: The jawans of 21 Rifles battalion seized contraband Indian goods worth Taka 15 lakh from different border areas of the district last week.

The BDR jawans raided several border areas and seized Indian goods including sugar, salt, cows, drugs, sarees, spare parts of bi-cycle, spades, bi-cycle, utenail and motor parts. The goods were deposited with the Customs authorities. None was arrested.

## One succumbs to burn injuries

KUSHTIA, May 14: One person succumbed to his burn injuries and two others were severely burnt in a fire incident which occurred at village Barulpur under Mirpur thana in the district on Sunday. All the victims were members of the same family.

Family sources said that in the evening on the day, a painter was working with spirit in the house of Khaibar Sardar at night, but due to negligence spirit caught fire. Khaibar, the house owner, his daughter Nazma Khatun, 20, and his son Tariqul Islam, 18, were engulfed in the fire. Their bodies were severely burnt. They were rushed to Kustia General Hospital where Tariqul died afterwards and the condition of Nazma was stated to be critical till filing of this report.

## 4 ICS leaders arrested in Rangpur

RANGPUR, May 14: Four local leaders of Islami Chhatra Shibir were arrested Wednesday on charge of terrorism, reports UNB.

The arrested were identified as Motaleb Hossain, district unit president of Chhatra Shibir and town unit secretary Mohammad Wadudullah, Shaifin, and Sanwar Hossain. Police said the four Shibir leaders on April 23 instigated the villagers of Adarshapara and Babukhan into a clash that left one person killed and 50 others injured.

The arrested were sent to jail after the court rejected their bail prayers.

## Outlawed party members held following clash

PABNA, May 14: Police arrested five members of the outlawed Purbia Banglar Communist Party from sadar thana following a clash with the supporters of ruling party that also left 10 people injured Sunday, reports UNB.

They arrested the outlaws — Sultan, 22, Mukam, 24, Khalil, 24, Taher 40 and Mabud 30 — along with some firearms, including a foreign made single barrel gun and several bullets.

Villagers said the clash between the rival groups, one led by Awami League leader Shahid Chairman and another by Sarbaha Party's Qamrul Master, occurred at 12 noon.

## Zia Parisad criticises govt attitude

## Dacoits stab houseowner before fleeing with booty

KUSHTIA, May 14: A dacoity was committed in the house of one Ahmad Hossain of village Gopalpur under Mirpur thana in the district on May 8 night.

Family and Police sources said that about 15 armed dacoits wearing mask called the owners of the house, Ahmad Hossain at dead of night. Ahmad Hossain did not respond. Then the dacoits forced their entry by breaking open the door. He shouted for help. Two of his sons, Majnu and Nur Ali rushed to help their father. Then the dacoits fired 4 rounds of blank fire. The dacoits stabbed Ahmad Hossain when he shouted again. His two sons tried to resist the dacoits, but they were also injured by the dacoits.

The dacoits looted 9 thousand taka in cash, valuable clothes, gold ornaments worth Taka 20,000 and escaped safely. The neighbours came to rescue to victims after the dacoits fled away. They sent Ahmad Hossain and his two sons in Kustia General Hospital. Hospital sources said that condition of Ahmad Hossain was very much critical.

## Crimes on rise in Sylhet

SYLHET, May 14: Abduction, dacoity, gun firing and other criminal activities have shot up at different areas in the district for last one week, reports UNB.

Sources said Afroza Begum Shipa, 12, was kidnapped from Kalyanpur area of the town on April 27. Afroza, daughter of one Aftab Miah, is a student of class five.

A case was filed in the local police station.

Meanwhile, Kotwali police on Thursday rescued Kamal who was abducted from the house of Habibur Rahman at Raihan Village on April 29.

Another report said a dacoity was committed at Jandohor village in Jakiganj thana of the district on Friday.

Police said armed dacoits stormed the house of Lutfar Rahman and looted valuables worth about Tk 2.13 lakh at gun point and fled away. A case was

registered with Jakiganj police station.

In a separate incident, police arrested Soibur Rahman Chowdhury for illegal firing from his licensed gun at Electric Supply area in the city on Sunday.

Sources said the firing took place following a dispute over construction of a toilet in the neighbour's house of Soibur Rahman who asked him to stop construction for the sake of environment pollution.

He opened fire as his neighbour refused to stop it. However, none was injured.

A team of Kotwali police led by Sub-inspector Hosneara Begum arrested a young man Babul from Vartokhola of South Surma. Babul, an accused in an arms case, was absconding, police said.

The arrested were identified as Ator Ali, Robinuddin and Borhanuddin.

## Two smugglers get RI on various terms

SATKHIRA, May 14: One person has been sentenced to suffer five years' rigorous imprisonment (RI) and fined Taka 1,000, in default to suffer 6 months' RI more for possessing smuggled goods.

The convicted person is Baker Ali of village Gobindakanti under sadar thana of the district.

The prosecution story in brief is that accused Baker Ali was caught red handed by the BDR personnel with Indian smuggled goods worth about Taka 18,320 from Garakhali in Kalaroa thana of the district on January 29, 1996. A case was lodged with Kalaroa police station later on.

Abdus Salam Sikdar, judge of special tribunal of court No-3, after examining the witnesses and documents announced the verdict of punishment.

Another report adds: Another person was convicted and sentenced to suffer 3 years' rigorous imprisonment (RI) and fined Taka 1,000, in default to suffer 6 months' RI more for possessing smuggled goods.

The victim is Manirul Islam of village Padma Shakhra under sadar thana of the district.

The prosecution story in brief is that accused Manirul Islam was caught red-handed by the BDR personnel with Indian goods worth Taka about 1,500 from Kulia under Debbhata thana on November 22, 1991. Rawnagul Islam, judge of special tribunal of court No-2 after examining witnesses and documents announced the punishment on May 7.

## Three killed in road accidents

SIRAJGANJ, May 14: Three people were killed and 13 others injured in two road accidents in sadar thana Monday, reports UNB.

Police said Abdur Rahim, 32, of Janpur village died on the spot as an earth-laden truck fell into a ditch near Ranigam at 7 am while two other travellers of its suffered injuries.

In another mishap, 13 people were seriously injured when two speeding trucks ramed a tempo one after another near Bhadrachal Hospital on new Dhaka Road.

Witnesses said a truck first hit the tempo from behind and soon another one loaded with Coca-cola crashed into it, leaving all the 13 passengers injured.

They were rushed to Sirajganj General Hospital where Janat Ali, 32, and Anwarah Begum, 30, died in the afternoon.

## Wanted dacoit arrested

SATKHIRA, May 14: Kaliganj police in a special drive rounded up one dacoit on May 5. He was wanted in connection with several dacoity cases.

The dacoit has been identified as Abdul Bari, 40, of village Krishnanagar in Kaliganj thana of the district.

Another report adds: Acting on a tip-off Debbhata thana police recovered one country made pipe gun and one round of cartridges on May 4.

## Truck load of tortoise worth Tk 35 lakh seized

Being informed by a secret source battalion commander Lieutenant Colonel Fazul Haq with a patrol party stopped the truck (Dhaka metro T-0020-700). Two people named Babul Haq and Manjur Hossain were also taken into custody. The detained goods have been submitted to Rajshahi Customs godown.

A case has been filed with Godagari thana in this connection.

## Body recovered

SATKHIRA, May 14: Kaliganj police recovered the body of a young man from a bush of village Raghunathpur under Kaliganj thana on April 29.

The body has been identified as Wazed Ali, 18, of village Hossainpur under the same thana.

Police sources said, the victim, Wazed Ali of Hossainpur has been missing since morning on April 29 and in the afternoon the local people found the body lying in the bush.

Police rushed to the place of occurrence and sent the body to Satkhira hospital. But the police could not ascertain till writing of the report whether Wazed Ali was murdered or committed suicide.
