Day temp may rise

Rain or thundershower accompanied by temporary gusty wind is likely at a few places over Barisal, Chittagong and Sylhet divisions and at one or two places over Dhaka, Khulna and Rajshahi divisions in the next 12 hours till 6 pm today, reports UNB.

The Met Office says day temperature may rise by 1 to 2 degree Celsius across the country.

The country's highest temperature 34.5 degree Celsius was recorded at Khulna and the lowest 20.5 degrees at Teknaf.

The sun sets today at 6:42 pm and rises tomorrow at 5:11 am.

World No-Tobacco Day today
Tobacco use kills 3m people a year globally: WHO

Bangladesh observes World No-Tobacco Day today with a series of programmes, organised by the government and citizens' groups against smoking, reports BSS.

The World Health Organisation (WHO) has chosen the slogan "United for a tobacco-free world" as this year's theme. It has also warned that tobacco use poses a public health hazard, killing three million people a year globally.

The main event of the day will take place at Osmany Memorial Hall at 9 am, where President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed will address as the chief guest a seminar, jointly organised by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Bangladesh Cancer Society and Adhunik. Minister for Health and Family Welfare Salahuddin Yousuf will address the seminar as special guest.

Meanwhile, a WHO report

said the death toll from tobacco use will rise to 10 million a year globally by the year 2020, unless strict measures are taken to control direct and indirect marketing and promotion of tobacco products.

WHO director General D R Hiroshi Nakajima warned against lenient public policy towards tobacco products and called upon societies to form coalitions against the lobbying and promotional activities of tobacco manufacturers.

WHO suggested a wide range of public policy actions to control tobacco use, including increased taxation on tobacco products and elimination of direct and indirect tobacco advertising; promotion and sponsorship.

The world health body also suggested that governments should promote economic alternatives to tobacco growing and manufacturing.

MOU signed with China to modernise telecom sector

A memorandum of understanding (MOU) was signed in Beijing yesterday between China and Bangladesh to modernise telecommunications in Bangladesh, reports UNB.

Post and Telecommunications Minister Mohammad Nasim, who is on a week-long visit to China, and Chinese Minister for Machinery Industries Bao Xuding witnessed the signing of the MOU, said a PID handout.

Earlier, Nasim visited NEC telecommunication manufacturing plant, built with Japanese cooperation, in the port city of Tianjin. The minister was taken around the factory and shown different production units.

Nasim met with Chinese Vice Premier Wu Bangguo at Zhongnanhai headquarters in Beijing on Thursday.

During the meeting, they discussed various issues relating to bilateral cooperation.

NARAYANGANJ, May 30: An employee of Adamjee Jute Mills was found dead at the mill compound under Siddhirganj thana this morning.

Mamun, 18, a shift helper of a loom division, was allegedly stabbed to death. Police said that they recovered his body from an open space between two godowns on the mill premises.

The body bore wound marks in the head and belly. The reason behind the killing could not be ascertained immediately.

Mamun was reported missing since he went out of his house at Aailpara area under Siddhirganj thana Thursday morning.


18th BCS written tests in Aug likely

It said the Commission would not reissue any admit cards for the upcoming tests. The details of the examinations will be published in the national dailies later.




