Greek envoy makes farewell call on Prime Minister

The Greek Ambassador to Bangladesh, Constantine Alianos, made farewell call on Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina at her Secretariat office yesterday, reports UNB.

In course of discussion on points of common interest, the Prime Minister recalled the age-old friendship between Bangladesh and Greece, the land of ancient civilisation.

"We need cooperation for our mutual development..... To keep pace with the development of outside world, we have to have excellent bilateral cooperation," she said.

Hasina said there is tremendous scope for cooperation between the two countries in the field of tourism, shipping, trade and commerce and training of Bangladeshi seamen in Greece.

The issues of jute export from Bangladesh and expanding and diversifying exports of other items from Bangladesh also came up for discussion in the meeting.

The New Delhi-based Greek Ambassador concurrently accredited to Bangladesh expressed his government's willingness to buy ceramic goods, jute carpet and other jute products from Bangladesh.

He also expressed his country's willingness to exhibit Bangladeshi products in Greece through trade fair.

Bangladesh Sixth Technical Assistance Project Individual Consultants for Telecommunications Regulatory Organisation Credit No. 2393-BD

The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit from the International Development Association in various currencies toward the cost of the Sixth Technical Assistance Project. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this credit will be applied to eligible payments under the contracts for consultant services. The Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, would like to engage individual consultant experts in three different fields to assist the ministry in the design and implementation of an appropriate regulatory framework for the telecommunications sector. The following consultants are required:

■ **Legal Expert in Telecommunications (8 staff-months):** The expert will review the legal, regulatory and institutional framework. Advise on the functioning of the regulatory body in light of regional and international experience. He/she will provide guidance to formulate policies and the legal framework for the telecommunications services. He/she should propose and draft guidelines or regulatory procedures which will be monitored by the regulatory authority. The expert should have a university degree in the relevant field and at least ten years' working experience in telecommunication laws and regulations of which some in developing countries.

■ **Expert in Frequency Management (8 staff-months):** The frequency management expert will prepare a national frequency plan and propose modern facilities for monitoring the radio spectrum. The expert should have a university degree in the relevant field and at least ten years' practical experience in spectrum management.

■ **Financial Analyst (5 staff-months):** The financial analyst will assist in developing the telecommunications tariff structure and contribute to the development of strategic plan for the telecommunications sector. The analyst should be a chartered account or have qualifications in a related field (e.g. MBA) and have at least ten years' experience in the telecommunications sector.

The detailed terms of reference can be obtained from the Chief of Planning, Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications (address below). Those interested in providing consultancy services in the abovementioned fields are requested to send in details of their qualifications, experience and other related information to the Chief of Planning, Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications, by June 24, 1997. Firms may also offer the services of the experts.
