Pottery exhibits at Alliance Francaise

An old Bengali art form took a new twist with the opening of a pottery exhibit at the Alliance Francaise Thursday night.

The Studio Pottery Exhibit is collection of 87 stoneware pieces by Sayeed Talukder; a soft-spoken potter and assistant professor at the Institute of Fine Arts, Dhaka University.

Talukder combined Chinese pottery techniques with Bengali clay to produce his new stoneware collection. Stoneware is fired at 1,200 degrees celsius, more than double the heat used for other pottery.

Madame Renee Veyret, France's Ambassador to Bangladesh, inaugurated the exhibition. A K Azad Chowdhury, Vice Chancellor of the Dhaka University, also attended the ceremony.

Talukder, 42, received his BA and post graduate degrees in pottery from Beijing and then trained at Chinese porcelain factories. Collections of his work are displayed at the National Museum and the Central Academy of Applied Art in Beijing.

After a brief speech, Madame Veyret went round the exhibit of bowls, dishes and vases with the artist. Veyret, who has tried her hand at pottery, said she was attracted to Talukdar's art because it felt good to the touch. The exhibition will run till June 18.
