the leprosy is a 100 per cent curable disease at all stages. It is caused by a germ and is not hereditary or a curse of God. The disease is mainly transmitted through the air.


Leprosy is considered to be the least infectious disease. In Bangladesh over 99 per cent of the population has immunity or resistance against leprosy and over 85 per cent of the cases are non-infectious, they added. They said about 80 per cent

of leprosy is non-infectious while only 20 per cent is infectious. It is possible to make the infectious leprosy into non-infectious within a month through the modern Multi-Drug Therapy (MDT) treatment.

MDT is a combination of three potent anti-leprosy drugs - Rifampicin, Clofazimine and

Experts said the leprosy germ from a patient can spread 3 to 5 miles in the air and it can survive a few hours. But there is adequate resistance in a man's body to kill the leprosy germ.

They stressed the need for creating awareness among the people about the disease that it is not an infectious disease and can be cured completely through treatment.


