Heavy rainfall forecast

Temporary west, southwesterly squally wind with 55-70 kph speed may sweep over the regions of Rajshahi, Pabna, Bogra, Faridpur, Dhaka, Mymensingh and Tangail during the next 15 hours till 11 am today, reports UNB.

The Met Office also forecast heavy rainfall at one or two places over Chittagong and Barisal divisions and Faridpur region during the period.

It said most places of Dhaka, Barisal, Sylhet and Chittagong divisions and many places of Rajshahi and Khulna divisions may experience rain or thundershower with temporary gusty or squally wind with the influence of south-west monsoon during the next 22 hours till 6 pm today.

The day temperature may fall by 1-2 degree Celsius over the country.

The country's highest temperature was recorded 36.6 degree Celsius at Rajshahi and the lowest 21.4 degrees at Ishwardi.

The sun sets today at 6:46 pm and rises tomorrow at 5:10 am.

They discussed matters relating to mutual interests and hoped that the existing relations between the two countries would further be strengthened in the days ahead.

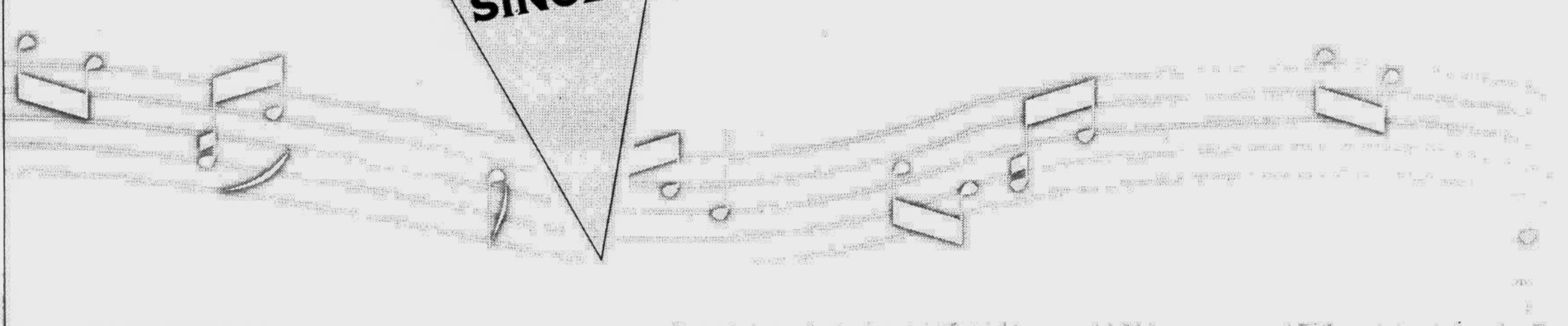
Autorickshaw driver killed
