Weather

Rain, thundershower forecast

Moderately heavy to heavy falls may occur at one or two places over Chittagong, Barisal divisions and the regions of Khulna in the next 12 hours till 6 pm today, reports UNB. Met office also forecast rain or thundershower accompanied by temporary gusty or squally wind at most places over Chittagong, Barisal and Rajshahi divisions.

South-west monsoon has set in over Chittagong division and is likely to sweep over the rest of the country in next 48 hours. The wind-driven surge of 2-3 feet may occur over the low-lying areas of the coastal regions.

Slight fall in day temperature is expected throughout the country.

In its outlook for subsequent two days weathermen predicted little change and forecast decrease in rainfall activity in the following five days.

Country's highest temperature 32.4 degree Celsius was recorded at Rajshahi and the lowest 18.2 degrees at Kutubdia.

The sun sets today at 6:46 pm and rises tomorrow at 5:10 am.

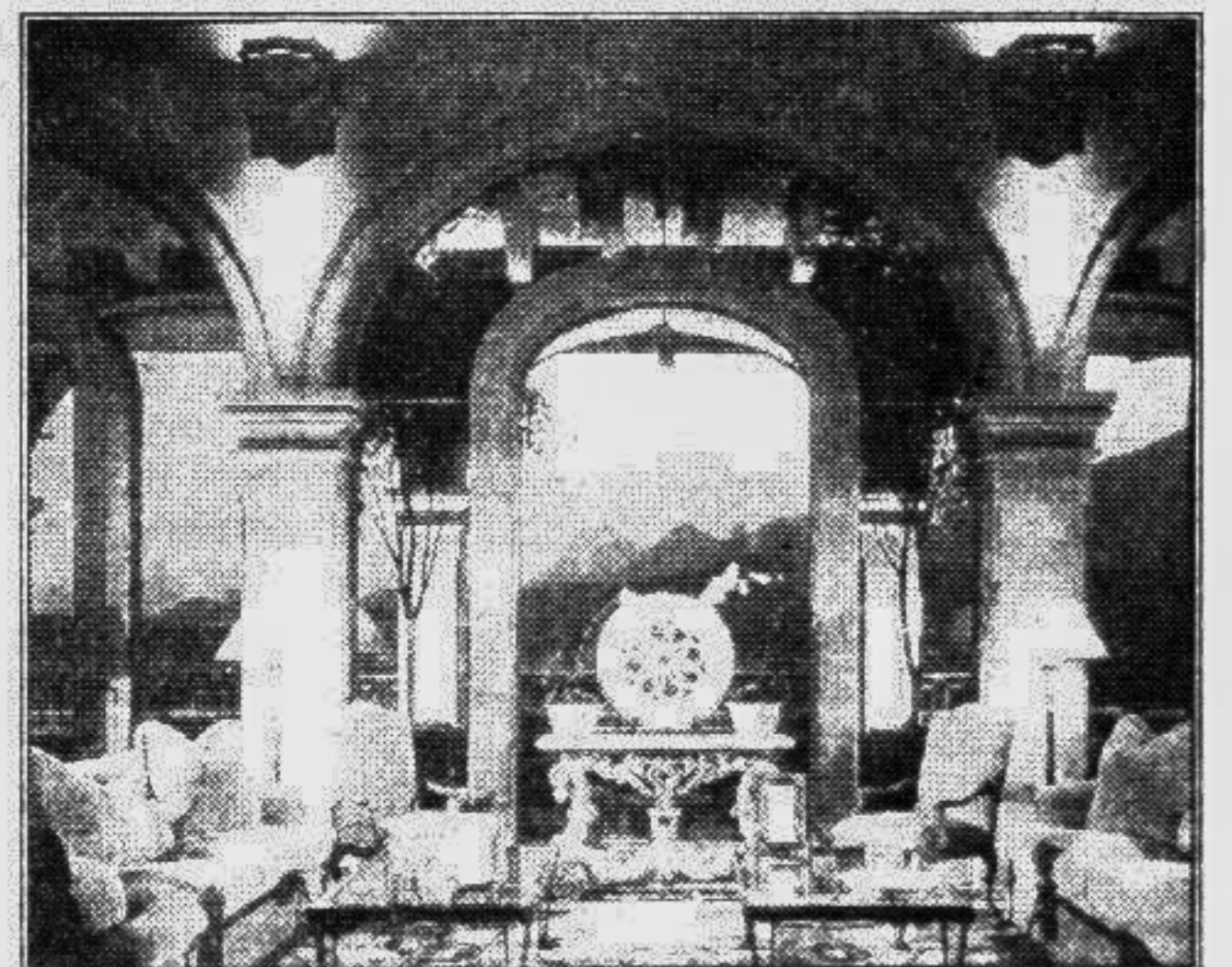
