Manikganj-3 byelection

Strict measures including 3-tier monitoring mechanism announced

The Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) yesterday spelt out strict measures, including a three-tier monitoring mechanism, for holding the Manikganj-3 byelection in a free, fair and impartial manner, reports UNB.

Announcing the measures Muhammad Abu Hena said the electoral code of conduct would be applied strictly and warned of instant action if anyone violated or failed to abide by rules.

tion after acceptance of its nine out of ten suggestions by the Election Commission regarding fair voting.

Elaborating on the measures, Abu Hena said the EC would constitute monitoring team headed by the Returning Officer with representation from contesting candidates at district level to monitor whether the election rules and code of conduct are being maintained properly or there is any irregularity.

Similar monitoring team led by Assistant Returning Officer will be formed at thana level.

Centrally, said the CEC, another monitoring team is being formed at the EC Secretariat with representatives from political parties.

He told the meeting that a two-member committee comprising district judicial officials had already started functioning to inquire into any pre-election irregularities and violation of code of conduct.

Moreover, arrangements have also been made for training all election-related officials and polling agents in Manikganj sadar and Satoria thanas to give them a clear idea about their duties.

He said adequate number of security personnel would be deployed in and around the polling centres to ensure a terrorism-free election.

Besides, mobile security units will work during the voting hours to ensure security of the voters.

The CEC made it clear that voting would be postponed instantly if violence occurred in any centre.

He told the meeting that all concerned officials should discharge their respective duties under the control of EC with the objective of holding the election in a free, fair and neutral way.

Partially, negligence or lapses will not be tolerated at all, Abu Hena said warning that instant legal action would be taken if any one failed to discharge duty neutrally.

He sought cooperation from all concerned in completing the forthcoming byelection smoothly.

PM tells JS

1032 members of army working in UN peace missions

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina told the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday that at present 1032 members of Bangladesh Army were working in different UN peace missions abroad as of June 1, 1997, reports BSS.

The members of the peace mission have earned 13,94,94,638.41 US dollars as salary and allowances, the prime minister said while answering a question from Treasury Bench member Mostafizur Rahman.

She said 764 members were working in the United Nations Iraq-Kuwait Observer Mission in Kuwait, six in the United Nations Mission for Referendum in Western Sahara, seven in the United Nations Protection Force in former Yugoslavia, 12 in the United Nations Observer Mission in Liberia, six in the United Nations Observer Mission in Georgia, two in the United Nations Military Observers in Tajikistan, 220 in the United Nations Angola Verification Mission-III in Angola, one in the United Nations special mission in Afghanistan, who is stationed in Pakistan, and 14 in the United Nations guards contingent in Iraq.

1.38 crore voters given ID cards

Some 1.38 crore voters were given identity cards and it was proposed to give such cards to the remaining voters by June 1999, parliament was told yesterday, reports UNB.

Replying to Advocate Khairul Enam (BNP-Laxmipur), Law Minister Abdul Matin Kharsu said there are 2,88,37,324 male voters and 2,80,15,440 female voters in the country.

Of them, 1,38,33,152 voters were so far given identity cards. Under the revised project proforma, it was proposed to provide the rest of the voters with such ID cards by June 1999.

The revised project proforma is now under consideration of the Executive Committee of the National Economic Council (ECNEC), the minister informed the House.
