The final day of the championships also produced the year's best performances in the men's 400-metre hurdles and







It was a dream come true when ICC. cricket's world governing body awarded Bangladesh with one-day



UNB adds: State Minister for Youth and Sports Obaidul Quader has congratulated Bangladesh Cricket Board (BCB) for achieving One-Day International status.


The State Minister also thanked the International Cricket Council (ICC), the world cricket body, for awarding due recognition to Bangladesh.
