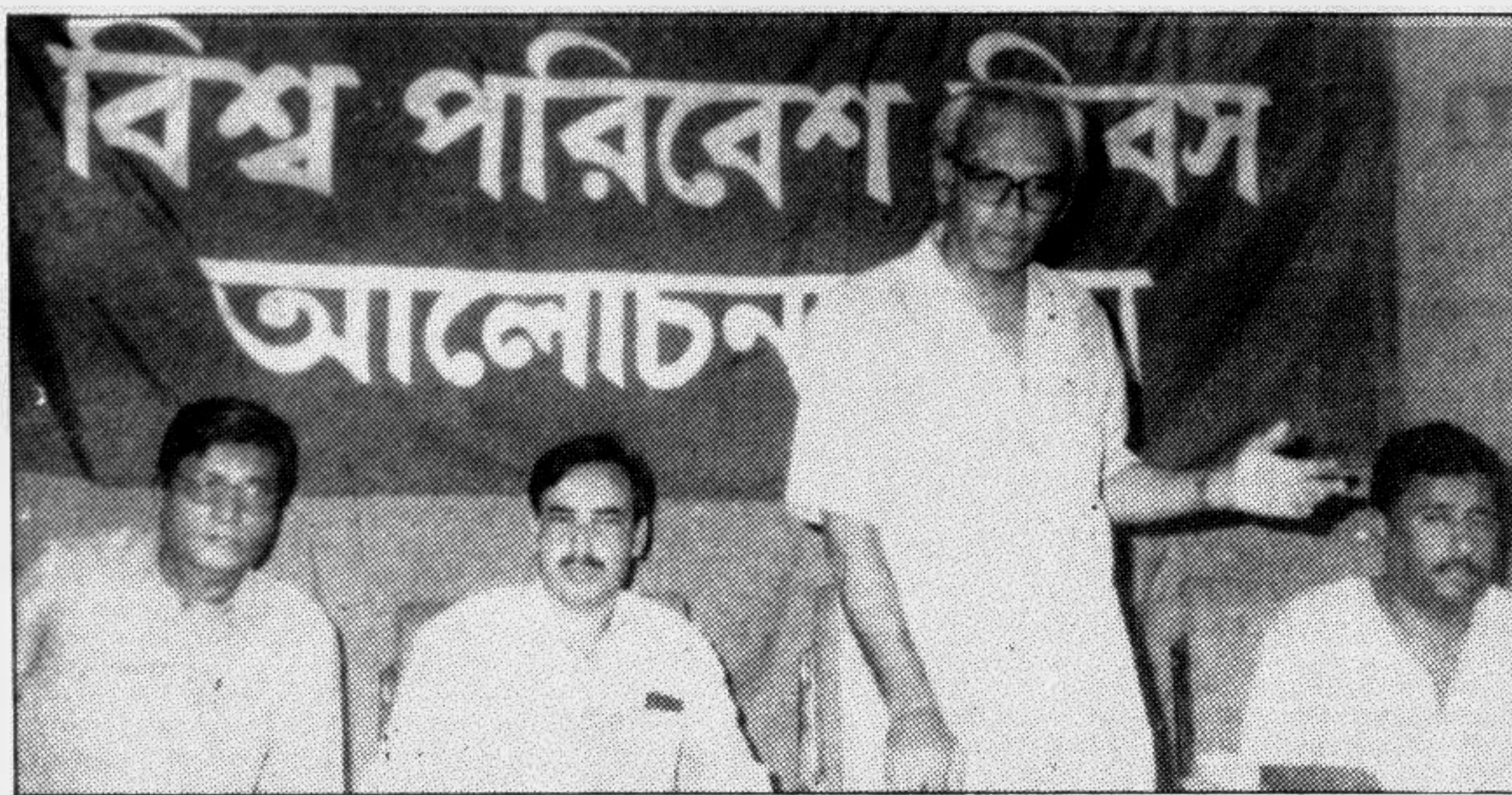

## People of Magura deprived of better postal service

MAGURA, June 17: Thousands of people in the remote areas of Magura district do not get better service from the Extra Departmental Branch Post Offices (EDBPO) due to lack of office buildings, furniture and adequate staff, reliable sources said.

According to reports, there are about 50 EDBPOs in four thanas of the district. Most of the EDBPOs have no office buildings, adequate furniture and staff.

About 70 per cent EDBPOs of the district were established during the period of British and Pakistani rule at the houses of village 'matbars', 'zamindars' or in the premises of 'maktabs' and clubs at local initiative. The local educated rural people including teachers, retired officials came forward to set up the

branch post offices half a century ago, some village elders said.

They informed, most of the branch post offices had been functioning as extra departmental till now, though the works of the branch post offices have increased manifold. The employees of the EDBPOs have been serving as extra departmental service holders. As a result, they are getting a small amount of money as allowances. They do not get salaries at all, official of EDBPOs said. It was also learnt from official sources, there are about 50 EDBPOs under departmental head and sub offices in four thanas of the district. These EDBPOs are located in the villages of Alukda, Keora, Chandpur, Jagla, Fulbaria, Bagla, Hajpur, Hat Jagdal under

Magura Head Post office, Talkhari, Dhaneswargati, Barachara, Harishpur, Bhabanhati bazar under Arpara SO, Gangni, Panighata, Gorail, Mondolgati, Banidig, Lahuria Kaligonj under Nohata SO, Digha, Dhoail, Palla under Muhmmadpur SO, Amalsar, Karandi Dhalaharachandra, Masalia under Langabandh SO and Kazali bazar, Kutichongachi, Khamarparabazar, Barisat, Malainagar, Srikol, Hal Amtail, Sachilapur and Sripur SO.

Besides, there are some extra departmental sub-post offices including Nakol EDSO, Binodpur EDSO in the district.

The local people alleged, they do not get better service due to lack of office building, furniture and adequate number of staffers.

## Female HSC examinee dies at exam centre

NATORE, June 17: A female examinee of Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examination died of cardiac arrest at the examination hall on Monday.

Papia Sarkar Rumi, 19, daughter of Ataur Rahman of village Jayantipur under Baraigram thana sat at Rani Bhavani Government Women's College for Social Welfare part-II examination at 2 pm on the day, witnesses and police sources said. Suddenly she fell sick and became unconscious at the hall room at around 3.30 pm. Then she was taken to Natore Sadar Hospital where on duty doctors declared her dead.

An 'unnatural death' case has been filed with Natore police in this connection. The dead body was sent to her village Jayantipur. Rumi, sat for the examination for the second time as she could not succeed last year.

## Khabor Editor, correspondent sued

RAJSHAHI, June 17: The Officer in Charge (OC) of Godagari thana of Rajshahi, Humayun Kabir Sarker has filed a case with the court of First Class Magistrate of Rajshahi Monday noon against the Editor and Publisher of the Dainik Khabor, Mizanur Rahman Mizan and its Rajshahi Correspondent Nazrul Islam for publishing false, fabricated, baseless and defamatory news items entitled 'Makho Tel, Felo Kori Nititey Rajshahi Police Proshashan' on May 14, 1997.

The plaintiff alleged, the news item and the editorial published on the same news on May 16, 1997, in the same paper had injured the prestige of the plaintiff and the district police.

On the basis of the charge filed against the accused persons, the court summoned the Editor and Publisher of the Dainik Khabor and its Rajshahi Correspondent under BPC Section 500, 501 and 502. The plaintiff was assisted by Advocate Shiraj Shaikat Salehim.

## Incident suppressed 25 feared drowned in Kalindi boat tragedy on May 24

KHULNA, June 17: Khulna district administration has reportedly suppressed the incident of missing of 25 persons in boat capsized on the night of May 24 in the Kalindi river under Shyamnagar thana of Satkhira district.

According to reliable sources, a mechanised boat loaded with 37 persons meant for smuggling through Kulta border capsized as a tornado hit it in mid-river.

Eyewitnesses said 12 persons swam ashore, while the rest are feared missing.

Local people said that they had found four dead bodies floating in the river. The Police Super (SP), Satkhira said that the matter was being investigated. The Officer-in-Charge (OC) Shyamnagar thana, when asked, confirmed the disaster and said that the missing people were all smugglers.

Relatives of the missing people have demanded a judicial inquiry into the matter.

## Satkhira Newsletter

SATKHIRA, June 17: An unmarried young girl was allegedly gangraped by a group of miscreants at dead of night on June 11.

The victim is identified as Jamila Khatun, 17, daughter of Abdul Sheikh of village Khusodanga under the sadar thana in the district. According to police sources, one Abdul Momin, son of Motaheb Sardar of village Khusodanga under the sadar thana with his accomplices Mofizul Islam and Sekendar Ali of the same village abducted Jamila Khatun from her house at night. They took her to a date tree garden, raped her one after another the whole night and left her in an unconscious state.

The villagers after being informed by the victim's parents rushed to the spot and rescued her. She was profusely bleeding.

She was shifted to Satkhira hospital in a critical condition. Shahidul Islam, the victim's brother filed a case with Sadar thana accusing Abdul Momin, Mofizul and Sekendar. None was arrested till writing of this report.

## 2 housewives commit suicide

Two housewives committed suicide by taking poison on June 8.

According to police sources, housewife Farida Khanam, 18, wife of Harooner Rashid of village Banda Kati under Kaligonj thana in the district, following family feud took poison and died on the spot. An unnatural death (UD) case was filed with Kaligonj police station.

In another incident, one Monju Ara Khatun, 20, wife of Hafizul Islam of village Raita under Assassuni thana took poison and died on the spot.

Family trouble is the cause of her suicide, police sources said. An unnatural death (UD) case was lodged with Assassuni thana.

## 2 snatchers get 7-yr RI

Two persons have been convicted and sentenced to seven years' rigorous imprisonment (RI) each and fined Taka 2,000, in default to suffer another six months' RI each on charge of Women and Children Oppression Act recently.

The convicts are Mostaq Sheikh and Jamal Ali Sheikh, both of village Mahandi under Tala thana in the district.

The prosecution story is that these two accused persons attacked Nasrin Islam, daughter of Nazrul Islam of village Mohandi of the same thana in broad day light while she was returning home from her school. They snatched away her gold chain, ring and wrist watch by stabbing her on July 22, 1995. A case was filed with Tala police station.

The Judge of the Special Tribunal Court No-4 after examining the witnesses and documents announced the verdict.
