Tk 2.46 cr Kurigram poura budget

KURIGRAM, June 18: Kurigram pourasava has announced Tk 2.46 crore annual budget for 1997-98 fiscal year with a surplus of Tk 21 lakh, reports UNB.

Pourasava Chairman Kaziul Islam announced the budget at a press conference held at pourasava auditorium on Wednesday. Of the total Tk 1.50 crore will be received from government grant and Tk 96 lakh from internal sources. Allotment of Tk 2.25 crore was earmarked for construction and development of various roads, ghats, bridges, culverts and markets, expansion of primary and mass education and slum development in the budget.

Bumper IRRI-Boro production

MAJDEE COURT, (Noakhali), June 18: Some 1,35,782 metric tons of IRRI-Boro paddy have been produced in the district during the current season, reports UNB.

Agriculture Extension office sources said during the season 44,314 hectares of land were brought under the programme. Of the total land, 39,854 hectares were brought under high yielding variety and 4,460 hectares under local variety.

School boy killed in road mishap

CHANDPUR, June 18: A primary school student was killed by a speeding passenger bus near Devpur under Haziganj thana on Tuesday on Chandpur-Comilla road, reports BSS.

The boy, Nazrul Islam, a student of Class IV, was crushed under the wheels of the bus while he was crossing the road. A case has been registered with Haziganj police station.

Tk 2.50 cr PWD project in Barisal

BARISAL, June 18: The Public Works Department (PWD) has been implementing a project here at a cost of Taka 2.50 crore in the current fiscal year, reports BSS.

According to an official source, three five-storey buildings are now under construction at sadar road here as the staff quarters of the judicial department. The project will be completed by the end of June.

Abducted woman yet to be rescued

SIRAJGANJ, June 18: Police failed to rescue a bride as yet who was abducted from the wedding party at Bhabanipur village in Kaziupur thana on Saturday, reports UNB.

According to family sources, Fatema Begum, 18, daughter of Abul Hossain of the village was kidnapped by Abdul Hamid of the village at night. Abdul Hossain arranged his daughter's marriage with Idris Ali, son of Khalil Mondol of the same village refusing earlier proposal from Abdul Hamid. A case has been filed with the police.

Workshop on child health care

SUNAMGANJ, June 18: A day-long workshop on mother and child health care organised by Sumanganj district information office held recently at Dherai Thana Parishad auditorium, reports BSS.

Deputy Commissioner Iqbal Hossain Khan inaugurated the workshop. Forty persons including school teachers, journalists, union parishad chairmen and imams participated in the workshop.

Indian smuggled goods seized

HABIGANJ, June 18: GRP police here seized Indian smuggled goods worth about Tk 1.5 lakh from an inter-district train at Shyestaganj Railway junction on Tuesday, reports UNB.

Police acting on secret information searched the Sylhet bound Parabat Express from Dhaka and recovered Indian sarees, lungis and spare parts from the guard room of 9687 no. boggy.

No health centres at 39 unions

SHERPUR, June 18: People of the district are deprived of proper treatment in absence of health centres at 39 unions in five thanas of the district, reports UNB.

According to district Health Department, at present, people of 51 unions have to depend on 12 health sub-centres situated in five thanas—four in Sadar, two in Sreebordi, two in Nakla, three in Nalitabari and one in Jhenidigha. Local elite said the poor people of remote villages including day labourers of the district often suffer from fever, cold and intestinal diseases but cannot avail the treatment facilities due to shortage of health centres.



MUNSHIGANJ: Each primary school going student is entitled to receive 20 kg of wheat per month according to Food for Education Programme (FEP) introduced by the government. Forest guards require sophisticated weapons

KHULNA, June 18: Armed terrorists and pirates are allegedly ruling in some of the areas of the Sundarbans.

The forest guards having no modern weapons are helpless to combat the menace.

There is no security of life and property of Bawalis, honey collectors, fishermen and even forest officials. Kidnapping for ransom by the pirates and terrorists and extortion of money from forest officials at gun point are being committed almost every day.

According to a reliable source, 25 persons were killed by pirates during the last one year and many people are missing. The terrorists and pirates have looted several crores of take from Bawalis fishermen and forest officials during the same period.

A responsible forest official of Chandpai range has confirmed that the entire Sundarbans area is in grip of at least 40 organised groups of terrorists. They are involved in looting fishing trawlers and kidnapping fishermen and Bawalis for ransom. They are allegedly looting wood cutters and honey collectors.

There are also instances that the terrorists do not hesitate to kill those who do not or fail to pay the desired amount of money.

The terrorists and pirates are in possession of all kinds of modern firearms whereas the forest guards do not possess modern weapons. So, it is not at all possible to protect the Sundarbans from the clutches of the terrorists at the risk of life. It is time to equip the forest guards with modern sophisticated weapons.

The recent combing operation in some of the black listed areas of the Sundarbans yielded no satisfactory result as the criminals managed to go into hiding.

2 RU journalists threatened

RAJSHAH, June 18: Two journalists of Rajshahi University (RU) were threatened to be killed by some alleged Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) workers Monday noon.

A complaint filed to the Commissioner of Rajshahi Metropolitan Police (RMP) by Harun-ur-Rashid Sarker, RU correspondent of the Al-Mujaddid and Masud Kibria, RU Correspondent of the Daily Sangram said that they were chased by some BCL activists. They threatened them aloud to kill them. Then the journalists, were returning to their dormitories after attending a meeting with the Administration of Public Relations office (PRO) section.

Flash flood in Gaibandha

GAIBANDHA, June 18: The low lying areas of five unions under Gaibandha district went under water due to flash flood by the rivers Brahmaputra and Ghagat during the last two days.

According to Water Development Board (WDB), water level in Brahmaputra and Ghagat suddenly increased due to onrush of water from the upper catchment area which overflooded some particular points of the two rivers. As a result standing crops on nearly 10 thousand acres of land of low lying areas were inundated under Gaibandha sadar and Fulchari thanas. The water level has continued to increase at all points.

With the sudden flash flood five unions namely Fazlupur, Arendabari and Fulchari under Fulchari thana, Gideri and Mollerchar under Gaibandha sadar thana have been affected seriously by flood water.

Journalists' rally in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, June 18: A journalists rally held here on Monday hailed the then government decision on June 16, 1975 regarding the newspaper industry, reports BSS.

In observance of June 16, the journalists rally was presided over by president of Chittagong Union of Journalists (CUJ) Anjan Kumar Sen.

Held at Chittagong Press Club, the rally was addressed, among others, by BFUJ vice president Kazi Jafarul Islam president of Chittagong Press Club, Abu Sufian general secretary Helaluddin Chowdhury, former president of press club Ataul Hakim, CUJ general secretary Shahidul Alam and former general secretary Swapan Kumar Mohajan.

The journalist leaders said although a large number of newspapers are being published in the country most of the newspapers are unable to play due role. Moreover, objective and responsible journalism are in helpless state because of yellow and prejudiced journalism by some of the newspapers.

Warrants of arrest on 2 police officers

HABIGANJ, June 18: A magistrate court here has issued warrants of arrest on two police officers allegedly involved in filing a false case against a UP chairman, reports UNB.

The warrants were issued on the basis of a CR case, against the former Police Super of the district Irfan Ali Khan and erstwhile Officer-in-Charge of Bahubal thana Rustam Alam.

According to prosecution, the former SP in connivance with the OC filed a case by producing fictitious documents against Abdul Haque, UP chairman of Jibonpur in Bahubal thana, under Arms Act on November 26, 1988.

But after examining the records and witnesses the then District, Sessions and Special Tribunal Judge M Zahurul Islam acquitted the accused and directed the lower court to file a case against six people including the SP and the OC for placing false documents before the court.

The case was pending for a long time and revived recently.
