



DESA clarification

The Dhaka Electric Supply Authority (DESA) has given the following clarification regarding the deaths of two persons at Maghbazar on June 19 & 20:

Two reports were published in the "Daily Star" on June 20 and 21 under the headlines "One electrocuted at Maghbazar" and "Another death for whose

The DESA is concerned with these two reports and wants to clarify the actual situation.

At about 11 pm on June 19, divisional control room got telephone message from one Alam that a person died due to electrocution when he came in touch with a live wire. Immediately, the power supply to the area was stopped by isolating breaker from Moghbazar substation in the interest of public safety. With the improvement of weather condition, departmental employees rushed to the site, repaired and energised the line at 2:30 am on June 20.

The second accident occurred when one Nargis was passing through the narrow road of Pyarabag at about 3:20 pm on June 20. She suddenly got in touch with a guy wire (which was electrified by a twisted service wire of a nearby house), got electrocuted and died. As soon as the divisional control room was informed of the incident by one Zaman over telephone at 3:20 pm, the power supply in the area was stopped for the better interest of public safety. The Executive Engineer, Operation and Maintenance Division, Tejgaon, after getting the news rushed to the spot with departmental employees. The area was thoroughly checked. the faulty service was disconnected and power supply in the area was restored at 5:20 pm on June 20. From the above clarifica-

tion, it is clear that the above two accidents were beyond the control of DESA and there was no negligence on the part of DESA employees.


