Metropolitan Police Welfare Society to set up garment factory

The Police Welfare Society, a cooperative of police personnel, plans to set up a garment factory for producing quality uniforms for the cops and generate an extra income of over Tk 50 lakh annually, reports UNB.

Official sources said Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and Home Minister Major (retd) Rafiqul Islam have already given their consent, in principle, to such a proposal which was sent through the Police headquarters.

The project proposal is expected to be finalised for implementation at the board meeting of the Society, popularly known as Polwel, to be held here on Wednesday.

Some 300 members of the distressed police families will be accommodated in the planned Polwel Garments to be set up at a cost of Tk 40 lakh at a rented building in the capital.

Quality uniforms at low

price for policemen would be ensured when the factory starts functioning, said a senior police official who is involved in project planning.

He said at present, the uniforms are fabricated through contractors at the district level. "In most cases, quality is poor and prices high," he added.

Some 90,000 police personnel — constables, ASIs and SIs — are given three sets of official uniforms for every 18 months by the government. Thus, Polwel Garments will have to produce 1.8 lakh sets of police uniforms a year.

Currently, the total number of policemen in the country is about 93,000. But inspectors and above, the police officials are given allowance to make their own uniforms.

The planned garment factory, however, will not be run by the police officials. Excepting the workers from distressed police families, all others will be appointed from outside based on their professional competence, the police official said.

At present, Polwel owns a commercial complex at the city's Naya Paltan that include a super market, a cinema and a printing press. It also owns a petrol pump at Malibagh crossing.

The police cooperative is going to construct another multi-storied commercial complex at Uttara, near Tongi bridge, costing Tk 20 crore.
