

The sex workers also demanded compensation as they are passing the days under open sky with their children and leading an inhuman life.

They alleged that ward commissioner Hossain Mollah, once a "god father" of the brothel, along with an organised gang attacked the women and children and looted all their possessions.

More than one thousand sex workers including 700 registered ones, are now scattered around the brothel at Kandupatti, they said.




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
