

Sachin's judgement day Pepsi denies accusation

> BOMBAY, June 27: US-based Pepsi Foods Ltd here Thursday vehemently denied it had insulted the Indian flag in one of its advertisements, blaming the row on a police mix-up, reports

The denial came after police in the western city of Bombay accused the firm of depicting the Indian flag with a cricket ball at its centre instead of a wheel on a billboard.

But a spokesman for Pepsi said he was "shocked and outraged at any suggestion that Pepsi has been less than respectful to the Indian national

Communications manager Deepak Jolly added the police were wrong in blaming the company, which had never used the Indian flag in its publicity campaigns.

He said the billboard at Bombay was "neither placed by Pepsi with its knowledge nor had it anything to do with Pepsi's business.

Jolly said the billboard was put up by a local company which was in charge of advertising during an international cricket tournament.


