Tk 4cr CCC plan for marine driveway

CHITTAGONG July 3: Chittagong City Corporation (CCC) has undertaken a plan to develop a 20-km marine driveway from Patenga to Fauzderhat here at a cost of Taka four crore.

Besides, introduction of travel trains, some observatory towers will also be built on the drive-way from which the tourists will view the setting sun in the vast sea, the sources said.

Power Development Board handed over a stretch of 20 km embankment to the city corporation authority on June 18 last and city mayor Alhaj ABM Mo-hiuddin Chowdhury yesterday visited the embankment site and planted a sapling of tree there.

As part of the development of marine drive-way, city corporation will plant some two lakh saplings of different varieties of trees on both sides of the embankment.
