Hotel boy commits suicide in city

On information, police recovered the body from room number 37 of Hotel Goldfish at 1, BCC Road in Sutrapur thana at about 11:30 am yesterday.

The manager of the hotel filed a UD case with Sutrapur police in this connection.

The body was sent to Sir Salimullah Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy.

HC extends stay order on Saidee's JS membership

The High Court on Thursday extended the stay order upon the judgement of Pirojpur district election tribunal declaring Maulana Delwar Hossain Saidee's parliament membership void, reports UNB.

The court fixed next Tuesday for hearing of the rule and extended the stay order upto that date.

Barrister Moudud Ahmed, appearing for Maulana Saidee, prayed for extension while Barrister Amir-ul-Islam, pleading for Sudhangshu Shekhar Halder, opposed the stay prayer.

But the court, after hearing both the sides, issued the stay-extension order fixing the date of hearing.

The Jamaat MP, Saidee, earlier had filed an appeal against the judgement of the election tribunal.
