Shaikat Mahmud Jishan, a student of Government Laboratory High School, has been missing from near the school at Dhanmondi since Monday morning.

Police said Jishan, 10, son of Noor Hossain, did not return to his house at 51, Moneshwar Road under Dhanmondi thana after school. He is a student of class four in the morning shift, which ends at 11 am.

Jishan, four feet and six inches tall with mixed complexion, was wearing the school uniform —white half-shirt and navy blue shorts.

Jishan's father, who hails from Begumganj in noakhali, has filed a general diary with the Dhanmondi thana.
