## **Enemies of independence** trying to use religion for political gains'

Speakers at a discussion held on the occasion of Eid-e-Miladunnabi in the city Friday underlined the need for resisting those who are trading in religion and trying to defame the Prophet Mohammad (SM) by wrong interpretation of the Holy Quran, reports BSS.

## Disruption of Miladunnabi function condemned

Various organisations have strongly condemned the unruly act of the fundamentalist elements disrupting the Eid-e-Miladunnabi function and insulting President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed and State Minister for Religious Affairs Moulana Nurul Islam at the Baitul Mukarram Mosque on Thursday, reports BSS.

In a joint statement Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA). Ekatturer Ghatak Dalal Nirmul Jatiya Samannay Committee (EGDNJSC), Bangladesh Muktijoddha Sangsad (BMS), Muktijoddha Sanghati Parishad (MSP), Bangabandhu Parishad, Joy Bangla Satigs-kritik Jote (JSJ), said the fundamentalists including Jamaat-Shibir created the situation in a planned manner to destroy the sanctity of Holy Eid-e-Miladunnabi.

They said the President was insulted as part of the conspiracy by this reactionary group who have been trying to destabilise the political situation of the country during the last few days, calling hartal on the issue of the heinous attempt to blaspheme Prophet Hazrat Mohammad (SM) by a Jewish woman.

They called upon the people to resist these heinous attempts of the fundamentalists.

Meanwhile, the Islamic Foundation authorities also expressed strong condemnation and protest against such nefarious activities.

In a press release, the foundation said the President came to the venue in time to inaugurate the Eid-e-Miladunnabi function. But some unruly elements under the cover of religion tried to create indiscipline in this august function. The function was disrupted as a result of this unexpected and unpleasant situation, it said.

Pro-Awami League Chhatra League has strongly protested the "attack and disruption" of the Eid-e-Miladunnabi pro-

gramme. In a statement, BCL president Enamul Haq Shamim and general secretary Ishaq Ali Khan Panna said the fundamentalist elements with ulterior motive dishonoured the all-respected President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed.

The Secretary General of Workers' Party Rashed Khan Menon strongly condemned the

heinous act of the fundamentalist forces.

In a press statement, Menon said the fundamentalists through this act had demonstrated their arrogance clearly indicating disregard to the holy religion and the Prophet of Is lam, Muhammad (SM)

"It is also a reflection of their design to create a political and communal issue in the country," Menon said, adding that the Khatib of the Baitul Mukarram Mosque might have instigated these elements to create anarchy in the Miladunnabi function.

Menon also expressed his dismay saying that the authorities had failed to ensure security of the President.

He demanded stern action against those responsible for such an unfortunate act.

Bangladesh Mujibnagar Karmachari Kallyan Sangsad blasted those who created chaos at the holy Eid-e-Miladunnabi programme.

Disrupting a holy religious function like the holy Eid-e-Miladunnabi is very painful as it is defamatory to Prophet Muhammad (SM), chairman of the Sangsad A Latif Khan and secretary general S M Zahangir Alam said in a statement.

They observed that the communal and anti-liberation forces disrupted the function with an ulterior motive to humiliate the President and the 12

crore people of the country. Chairman of Bangladesh Muktijoddha Smriti Sangrakhan Sangsad M Ubedur Rahman Choudhury in a statement urged the government to take stern action against these elements who had long been giving false interpretation of religion and working against the state under various religious banners.

He also urged the government to cancel the citizenship of these elements who had opposed the country's Liberation War in 1971.

President of Bangladesh Islami Biplobi Parishad Moulana Sheikh Obaidullah Bin Sayeed Jalalabadi in a statement said that language fails to express condemnation of such an act showing insult to a holy place like Baitul Mukarram Mosque and the President of the coun-

#### Bhuiyan demands withdrawal of cases against BNP men

BNP secretary general Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan yesterday demanded immediate release and withdrawal of 'false' cases filed against his partymen, reports UNB.

In a statement, he said police arrested Rampal thana Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) activists Ziaur, Azizul, Shariful, Mizan, Milon and Mostafa on July 3 during hartal under the Special Power Act and filed 'false' cases against many oth-

He said the JCD leaders and activists could not appear at ex-aminations due to "terrorism unleashed by the ruling party" at Rampal, disrupting their academic career.

"Through the administration is totally aware of the situation, it is showing reluctance regarding the problems of JCD leaders and workers," Bhuiyan

The BNP leader also alleged that his party leaders were not even being allowed to do business. "Despite this stifling situation, the administration is not taking any step to restore peace at Rampal thana."

In its outlook for the subsequent two days weathermen predicted increase in rainfall activity-No appreciable change in day temperature is likely across the country.


