

# Metropolitan Major rivers continue to fall at all points

## Fees hike protested GCO calls strike at DU July 28

Ganotantik Chhatra Oikya (GCO), a conglomerate of some left-leaning student organisations has called a day-long strike at the Dhaka University on July 28 protesting increase of admission fees and other related charges of the university.

The announcement of the strike was made at a rally held yesterday on the Dhaka University campus. Earlier the GCO activists brought out a procession on the campus.

The Vice Chancellor, met the GCO leaders in the evening and promised to reduce the fees by 45 per cent. But the leaders of the GCO were not convinced.

The Dhaka University Syndicate decided to increase the admission and other charges from Tk 1300 to Tk 2600 at its meeting recently.

A large number of students of the university have demanded of the university authorities of rescinding the decision to increase the fees.

The Brahmaputra and the Ganges continued to fall at all points while the rivers in Meghna and South Eastern Hill basins observed fall at all points except the Khowai at Habiganj in last 24 hours till 6 am yesterday, reports UNB.

According to a Flood Information Centre bulletin, the Ganges at Bhagyakul, the Surma at Kanaighat, the Kushiya at Amalshid and Sheola and the Meghna at Bhairab Bazar were flowing above their respective danger levels.

The bulletin forecast that the flood situation of Goalundo thana in Rajbari district, Lohajong and Srinagar thanas in Munshigonj and Dohar and Nawabganj in Dhaka may improve further in next 24 hours.

However, it further forecast that the river Ganges may flow 28 cm above danger level at Bhagyakul while the Meghna may flow 8 cm above danger mark at Bhairab Bazar in the period.

In Brahmaputra basin, the Brahmaputra registered further fall by 20 cm at Noonkhawa, 10 cm at Chilmari, 5 cm Bahadurabad, 13 cm at Sirajganj and 12 cm at Aricha. The Dharla at Kurigram also marked fall by 22 cm.

The Teesta also recorded fall by 11 cm at Dalia and 13 cm at Kaunia while the Old Brahmaputra observed further fall by 12 cm at Mymensingh. All the rivers in this basin were flowing below their respective danger levels.

In Ganges basin, the Surma recorded further fall by 15 cm at Kanaighat, 18 cm at Sylhet and 12 cm at Rajshahi, 12 cm each at Hardinge Bridge and Goalundo while slight fall at Pankha and Bhagyakul. It was still flowing 30 cm above the danger level at Bhagyakul.

In South Eastern Hill basin, the Muhuri at Parshuram marked fall by 88 cm, the Haldia at Narayan Hat by 25 cm and at Panchpukuria by 21 cm.


