JMB changing socio-economic conditions in project area

"Yesterday, just a dream, today, a glorious reality," is the slogan written on the entrance of Jamuna Bridge at Bhupur, Tangail, welcoming the people to visit the "miracle over the Jamuna," reports BSS.

The 4.8 kilometre multimillion-dollar Jamuna Multipurpose Bridge (JMB), the 85 per cent construction work of which is completed, is not only a glorious reality now, but it has also started to bring changes in the socio-economic conditions of the people living in the bridge project area.

With the effective implementation of programmes like Revised Resettlement Action Plan (RRAP), Erosion and Flood Action Plan (EFAP) and Environmental Management Action Plan (EMAP), nearly 200,000 affected people of both sides of the bridge experienced a dramatic change in their social life.

Mohammad Hannan, 30, a day labourer working at the JMB for the past 13 months, is one of the lucky ones among the 100,000 project affected persons (PAPs) at Bhupur site of the bridge who were rehabilitated in the resettlement area. He expressed happiness over achieving financial solvency for his 11-member family.

Hannan was given an one decimal of land within the resettlement area of Bhupur and Taka 91,000 in cash nearly one year back as his one acre at Nalchiar was acquired by the government for constructing JMB.

Like many others, Mohammad Ishaq Ali, 35, of Pattitapara village at Bhupur who was also compensated under RRAP, is awaiting operation of traffic on the JMB. He believes that he would earn much more than the present income of Taka 4500 per month at the JMB project site.

The Jamuna Multipurpose Bridge Authority (JMB) spent a total of Taka 163.2 crore for resettling the people living on 150 hectare affected by the project under RRAP, involving the non-government organisations (NGOs), said Programme Officer (Infrastructure) of World Bank KM Maqsoodul Mannan.

The NGO who are involved in implementing the entire spectrum of activities of RRAP, EFAP and EMAP are: BRAC, Rural Development Movement (RDM), Manab Kalyan Sangstha (MKS), Grameen Bank, RADOL and SOBASS.

The RRAP is implemented under the suggestion and guidance of the World Bank, one of the co-financiers of the bridge which is providing 200 million US dollars of the total cost of 800 million US dollars.

Mannan said a flood-free resettlement site has been developed and is functioning effectively in the vicinity of JMB. The site has been provided with schools, clinics, sanitary latrines and road facilities, he added.

The World Bank programme officer said the people affected by JMB have substantially been compensated under an ambitious package of programme by the JMB. The package includes transfer grant, house construction grant, one time cash grant, dismantling and removal grant, one time moving assistance grant, grant to cover maximum allowable replacement value (MARV) and grant to purchase homestead plot.

Mannan said the government is contemplating to compensate those affected by flooding and erosion due to construction of JMB.

He said the environment programme has also successfully been completed by the JMB.

"Tremendous development would take place in the north west part of the country as the government has already decided to set up export processing zones in Ishurdi and other places of northern Bangladesh after completion of the bridge," Deputy Project Manager of JMB Brig (rtd) AHM Abdullah told BSS.
