SKOP's 24-hour countrywide strike today

By Staff Correspondent The Sramik Karmachari Oikya Parishad (SKOP), an alliance of country's trade union organisations, will enforce a 24-hour countrywide strike today to press its 8-point demand.

SKOP decided to go ahead with the strike programme, the first since the Awami League assumed power, as all negotiations between the trade union leaders and the government failed last night.

Shah Alam, General Secretary of the Jatiya Sramik Federation, a component of the SKOP, told The Daily Star late last night that the talks with the government failed as it refused to make any commitment on the demand for stoppage of disinvestment of public sector enterprises.

KHULNA, July 29: The European Union (EU) has banned the entry of Bangladeshi shrimps to its member countries, according to shrimp exporters

Shrimp exporters of Khulna will incur financial loss of over Tk 100 crore due to the cancellation of contracts with buyers from European countries including the UK. Germany. France, Belgium and Holland, the exporters said.

N-reactor: Work on to pinpoint leakage

By Reaz Ahmad and Govinda Shil, back from Savar

A probe and repair committee comprising nuclear scientists and experts will empty the faulty 'Decay Tank' of the nuclear reactor at Savar to pinpoint the leakage and start repair work within a day or two. officials said vesterday.

Operation of the 3-MW nuclear reactor of the Atomic Energy Research Establishment (AERE) has remained suspended since July 17 as a leakage developed in its cooling system,

technically called 'Decay Tank' Meanwhile, experts are divided on the cause behind the leakage. Some say it may be because of a built-in problem




