People want to get rid of AL govt: Khaleda

BNP Chairperson Begum Khaleda Zia yesterday said the government would not be able to complete its tenure as people became fed up with it for its activities, reports UNB.

"Situation will not permit the government to complete its five-year term. People now want to get rid of this anti-people and subservient government," she said.

Addressing the newly elected office bearers of Dhaka city unit of Jatiyatabadi Stramik Dal at her Minto Road official residence, she said the Awami League government was running the country at the dictate of its 'masters' and took stand against the people.

She told the function that the people were now eagerly waiting for BNP's street agitation. Professionals and different groups of patriotic people are now pressuring BNP to launch anti-government movement.

"We will have no choice but to go for oust government movement in near future to protect the independence, sovereignty and democracy of the country and free the people from repression and exploitation," the BNP chief said.

The Leader of the Opposition said a government sans patriotism has no responsibility to the nation and "all its activities aimed at pleasing its masters who had helped them come to power."

In over one year, she noted,

the government has not implemented a single commitment given during the election to the people.

She said the government made life of common people unbearable as prices of essentials increased tremendously.

Begum Zia said though the pay commission report was submitted and the head of government announced its implementation, there was no initiative to implement it. There is also no allocation of money for it.

The opposition leader demanded full implementation of the Pay Commission recommendation and formation of wages commission.

She said, people are not being allowed to freely practise their respective religion as the government started capturing religious institutions.

Referring to government decision of changing the name of Zia International Airport, Begum Zia said the government is now saying that it had not changed the name of any airport following tremendous pressure from the people.

"But there is government circular in our hand. The circular has also been published in newspapers," she said and demanded that the government withdraw the circular through official announcement.

Central leaders from BNP and Stramik Dal also spoke on the occasion.

Commenting on the BTV's response to his party's pre-conditions, BNP Secretary General Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan, MP, told The Daily Star last night, "We don't find any relevance of the BTV reply to our letter."

Asked about his party's position on the BTV programme, he said, "We'll discuss the matter today and let the authorities know our position."

Monday's letter by the BTV DG was his second to the BNP inviting the Leader of the Opposition to reply questions from a panel of experts and others through the programme.

The DG also referred in the letter to his earlier talks with two BNP leaders on the opposition party's pre-conditions for Begum Zia's participation in the BTV programme.

The BTV DG held a meeting with two BNP lawmakers — MK Anwar and Dr Khandakar Mosharraf Hossain — on July 24 following a BNP letter putting some conditions for the BNP chief's participation in the programme and seeking a discussion with the BTV authorities on the matter.

During the meeting, the BNP representatives set several pre-conditions seeking neutral coverage of their programmes including one planned for the party chief, while the DG assured them of BTV's sincerity, honesty and transparency in dealing with the programme for Begum Zia. However, the meet ended inconclusively.

Earlier, the BTV wrote a letter to the BNP chief requesting her to attend the Deebashir Mukhomukhi programme the day after PM Sheikh Hasina had appeared in the programme on June 23.

ated for 24 hours from 10 am today. The *bonafide* resident students of the hall would be allowed to enter the dormitory only after checking their identification cards.

Mob snatch away 3 arrested persons from police

CHITTAGONG, July 29: A mob snatched away three arrested persons from the police and took away one magazine of sub-machine gun (SMG) loaded with 20 bullets near Chhunowa bazar under Banskhal thana last night, reports BSS.

Banskhal thana OC Moezzem Hossain said a contingent of police was returning after arresting the three persons from village Chhunowa when hundreds of villagers attacked them suddenly. The three are accused in a triple-murder case.

The villagers started pelting stones at the police and attacked them with sticks and other weapons. At one stage, most of the police men were held hostages.

In the meantime, the villagers snatched away the arrested persons and took away the magazine.

Three policemen were injured in the incident.

Garments workers to gherao BGMEA office tomorrow

Eight garments workers unions will gherao the BGMEA office tomorrow to realise their five-point demand, reports UNB.

A press release signed by Bangladesh Textile Workers League (BTWL) president ZM Kamrul Anam yesterday also stated that the unions have expressed solidarity with SKOP called today's work-stoppage programme.

The unions include BTWL, Combined Tailor-workers Federation, Garments Workers League, Garments Workers & Employees Federation and Garments Workers Federation.

BSS adds: Bangladesh Garments Stramik Kalyan Samity (BGSKS) said the garments workers will not observe today's strike, for the sake of the country's economy as well as their livelihood.

The strike has been called at a moment when the foreign entrepreneurs are coming up with their investments, being encouraged by the government's policy, a BGSKS press release said.

This strike will only serve the interest of some political and worker leaders, it said.

The SKOP demands include fixation of the minimum wage of the private sector industrial workers at Taka three thousand per month, stoppage of disinvestment of the public sector industries and their establishment and re-opening of the already laid-off industries.

On the SKOP demand for minimum wage for the private sector industries, a written government proposal sent to the leaders yesterday said that a Wage Commission would be constituted within the next six months and that the government would request the Commission to propose a minimum wage for the workers. The Wage Commission recommendations would be implemented with retroactive effect from July 1, 1997. The proposal, however, did not say what the minimum wage would be.

To drum up the strike, beginning at 6 am today (Wednesday), several hundred SKOP workers brought out a procession in the city yesterday.

The strike will be enforced in all government and private mills and factories. Sarak Paribahan Federation also supported the strike, indicating a disruption in road communications.
