### Day temperature may fall

Moderately heavy to heavy fall is likely at places over Barisal and Chittagong divisions in the next 12 hours till 6 pm today, reports UNB.

Met office also forecast moderate rain or thundershower accompanied by temporary gusty wind at most places over Barisal, Chittagong and Sylhet divisions and at many places over Dhaka, Rajshahi and Khulna divisions.

Slight fall in day temperature is likely during the period across the country.

In its outlook for subsequent two days weathermen forecast increase in rainfall activity. Giving extended outlook for another five days the weather office predicted decrease in rain at the end period.

Meantime, Tangail experienced the highest 55 mm rain in the last 36 hours till 6 pm today. Patuakhali had 50 mm. Sandwip 48, Chandpur and Srimangal 40 each, Rangamati 39, Dhaka 36, Dinajpur 35, Teknaf 25, Madaripur 23, Feni 20, Barisal 18 and Faridpur 17mm during the period.

Country's highest temperature 33.2 degree Celsius was recorded at Rajshahi and the lowest 24.5 degrees at Rangpur and Rangamati.

The sun sets today at 6:35 pm and rises tomorrow (Tuesday) at 5:33 am.

## High-yielding variety of kakrol evolved

RAJSHAHI, Aug 10: The Genetics and Breeding Department of Rajshahi University and Fruits Research Centre of Rajshahi have jointly evolved a new variety of 'kakrol' recently, reports BSS.

The production of new variety of 'kakrol' will be around sixty five metric tons per hectare in a year whereas the general variety produced about forty five metric tons, according to a university press release.

While releasing the high-yielding new variety of 'kakrol' at a function here Thursday, the vice-chancellor of Rajshahi University Prof Abdul Khaleque said, "we must evolve new technology and conduct more research work for boosting production in agriculture to meet the growing demand of the people of the country."

The chief scientific officer of Agriculture Research Centre Institute, Mohammad Hafizur Rahman chaired the function.

Prof Obaidul Islam Joarder, president, Genetics and Breeding Department, Prosanto Kumar, senior scientific officer of Fruits Research Centre and Prof. M Anisur Rahman, chairman, Botany Department of Rajshahi University, among others, spoke on the occasion.

## DCC yet to decide on reopening of Public Health Lab

Dhaka City Corporation (DCC) authorities are yet to take any firm decision to expedite reopening of its Public Health Laboratory — the only official centre for testing quality of food in the city, sources concerned confirmed.

"It has been decided that the laboratory would be shifted to the DCC's environment building but nothing else has been done to expedite the procedure," an official source said.

The laboratory has remained inoperative since it was shifted from Laxmibazar to Nagar Bhaban nearly four months ago. At Nagar Bhaban the laboratory was not allowed to reopen and the Health Department officials have blamed 'internal foul play' for the closure. The manpower and the equipment of the laboratory have been lying idle ever since.

DCC sources further said activities of the environment development wing of the DCC will face uncertainty as the authorities have not decided where they might be shifted once the laboratory is installed there.
