Nasim tells Bellcore projection meet

Plan to lay optical fibres between Dhaka, Ctg

Post and Telecommunications Minister Mohammad Nasim yesterday said the government is deregulating and privatising the telecommunications sector to fulfill its commitment to the WTO charter, reports BSS.

The minister said we have already switched over to digital telephone system in the major cities and have plans to lay optical fibres between Dhaka and Chittagong with eventual connection with SEA-ME-WE Global-3 submarine cable across Cox's Bazar.

Nasim said licenses have been given to three private companies with technical collaboration of foreign countries to operate cellular telephones. Two companies have already started operation, while the third will start functioning

The minister said the government has formed a separate wireless board as the number of wireless phones is increasing. Nasim was addressing a

firm of the United States, at a city hotel yesterday.

The meeting was also addressed by Charge d'Affaires of the US Embassy Dhaka T Nist, Chairman of Bangladesh Telephone and Telegraph Board M. A. Mannan Chowdhury and Bellcore executives Dr. M. Hoque and Dr. H. Yuce.

Bellcore executives introduced the audience to asymmetrical digital subscriber line (ADSL) system and narrated Bellcore's experience in spectrum management system.

They said ADSL technology is able to ensure high rate of transmission using existing copper loops in Bangladesh. It will provide data and telephone simultaneously, make available high speed internet services and promote rural education by interactive videos. But they admitted that this system will not work" in total fibre optics environment and the rate of transmission through existing copper loops in Bangladesh will be 6 mbs (mega-bytes per second).




