Nat'l Mourning Day programmes in Ctg, Rajshahi, Khulna

Chittagong
Elaborate programmes have been undertaken in Chittagong to pay tributes to the Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman in observance of National Mourning Day, commemorating the 22nd anniversary of his assassination today, reports BSS.

In the city, today's programmes will be heralded with hoisting of the national flag at half-mast atop all private and public buildings and educational institutions.

Other programmes include, wearing of black badges, placing wreaths by the portrait of Bangabandhu, discussions and seminars, blood donation, tree plantation, feeding of destitutes, milad mahfil, khatme Quran, essay and painting competitions and cultural function.

The programmes of the district administration include a discussion meeting on 'Bangabandhu and Bangladesh' at Shilpakala Academy.

Chittagong City Corporation, Bangabandhu Parishad, Chittagong University, Communist Party of Bangladesh, Amra Shishu Kishore, Chittagong city unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League, Chittagong Press Club and Chittagong Union of Journalists, Bangabandhu Law College, Coaster Hatch Contractor Workers Union, Bangabandhu Smriti Sangsad, Chittagong City Rickshaw Samik League, Bangladesh Muktiuddha Sangsad,

Imam Training Centre, Chittagong and Bangladesh Shishu Academy are among the organisations which will observe the day.

Special prayers will also be held at all Juma congregations and other places of worship.

Rajshahi
The National Mourning Day will be observed in Rajshahi region in a befitting manner today.

National flag will be hoisted at half mast at government, semi-government and educational institutions to mark the day.

Special prayer will be offered at mosques after Juma prayers and other places of worship for the peace of the soul of Bangabandhu and continued peace and progress of the country.

Bangladesh Awami League, Rajshahi district and city units, and their front organisations have drawn up elaborate programmes, which include hoisting of national and party flag at half mast, and black flag at party office at Gonokpara in the morning, garlanding the portraits of Bangabandhu and four national leaders Syed Nazrul Islam, Tajuddin Ahmed, Captain Moonsur Ali and AHM Kamruzzaman, wearing black badges and mourning procession.

Besides, milad mahfil, discussion, meeting, cultural function, feeding of destitutes, essay and song competitions for school children will be held.

Recorded speech of Banga-

bandhu will be played at different points of the city on the day. Rajshahi Shishu Academy, Mujibuddha Sangsad, Awami Juba League, Railway Sramik League and other organisations of the region will also observe the day.

Khulna
National Mourning Day will be observed in Khulna today through various programmes. Bangladesh Awami League, its front organisations, large number of educational institutions and socio-cultural organisations have arranged elaborate programmes to mark the day.

Khulna City Awami League will hoist the national flag and black flag at its office at half mast while members of the party will wear black badges.

They will garland the portrait of Bangabandhu and bring out a mourning procession. Koran Khwani, special prayer, feeding of destitutes and milad mahfil have been arranged on the occasion. A discussion on the life and contributions of Bangabandhu towards the nation will be held tomorrow at the party office.

Separate programmes have been chalked out by Islamic Foundation, Khulna branch, Swadhin Chikitsak Parishad, Krishi Bank Karmachari Sangsad, Bangabandhu Sangbadik Parishad, Betaga Adarsha Club, Khulna Press Club, scores of educational institutions and Khulna branch of Jatiya Mahila Parishad.

Former member of parliament and an eminent litterateur Begum Dawlatunnessa Khatun died of old age ailments at Rangpur Medical College Hospital recently. She was 92, reports BSS.

Begum Dawlatunnessa was elected a member of provincial assembly in 1954. She was again elected member of parliament from Gaibandha-Kurigram constituency 1979.

She was the first woman parliamentarian who moved the anti-dowry bill in the parliament.

K A Matin Amzad, a retired general manager of Uttara Bank, died of a massive heart attack Wednesday night at his Uttara residence. He was 62, family sources said, reports BSS.
