A maid died reportedly after falling from the third floor of a building at Kalabagan under Dhanmondi thana in the city Thursday morning.

Details about how she fell down could not be known immediately. However, Dhanmondi police said yesterday the woman met with the accident while sweeping the veranda at about 9 am.

The body was sent to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital for autopsy.
