A maid died reportedly after falling from the third floor of a building at Kalabagan under Dhanmondi thana in the city Thursday morning.

The dead, aged about 40, is yet to be identified. Police said the woman began work the apartment building at Lake Circus about a week ago.

Details about how she fell down could not be known immediately. However, Dhanmondi police said yesterday the woman met with the accident while sweeping the verandah at about 9 am.

The body was sent to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital for autopsy.

An unnatural death (UD) case was filed with Dhanmondi thana.

Nat'l Mourning Day observed

The National Mourning Day commemorating the 22nd death anniversary of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman was observed on Friday in the city as elsewhere in the country in a befitting manner, report agencies.

Foreign Minister Abdus Samad Azad called upon all democracy loving people to be united against conspiracies against the spirit of the Liberation War.

He was addressing a discussion at the National Museum in the city on the day.

The minister said Bangabandhu was killed right at a moment when he had started programmes for the economic advancement of the country.

The discussion was addressed, among others, by Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzak, Commerce and Industries Minister Tofael Ahmed, Prof Kabir Chowdhury, Abed Khan and A Z M Rafique Bhuiya.

Mustafa Nurul Islam chaired.

Awami League General Secretary and LGKD and Cooperatives Minister Zillur Rahman said the government is committed to building the country as a Sonar Bangla as dreamt by Bangabandhu by making society free from exploitation, hunger, poverty, illiteracy and unemployment.

Zillur said this while distributing food among the destitutes in different city areas on the day.

Awami League central office arranged a Qurankhwan, milad mahfil and feeding of destitutes at 23 Bangabandhu Avenue.

Kakrail Public Health Engineering Department, Dhaka City Jubo League (south) ward No. 71, Dhaka City Hawkers' League, Bangladesh Awami Ain Chhatra Parishad, Bangabandhu Sangskritik Gosti, Bangabandhu Anusari Manch, Bangladesh Chinnamul Hawkers League and Dhaka Mahanagar Hawker Oikya Parishad also distributed food among the poor on the day.

Academics, Scientists and Litterateurs, at a discussion, organised by Bangla Academy said Bangabandhu appeared as the leader of the Bengalee nation at a transitional period of history but there is no denying the fact that he created history too.

Faizur Rahman, 72, retired director, Water Development Board, died of heart attack yesterday at his Dhanmondi residence, says a press release.

His namaz-e-janaza will be held today after Zohr prayers at the Mosque of Road: 12, Dhanmondi. He will be buried at Banani Graveyard.

Ahmed Ishaque Abdullah (Kanak), son of Md Ataur Rahman and Hasina Rahman, died in a road accident near Red Wings, Minnesota, USA, on Aug 11. He was 24, says a press release.

He was studying Computer Science at Winona State University.

His body is scheduled to arrive in the city today.

CHITTAGONG, Aug 16: Alem Peer-E-Kamel Hazrat Molana Sultan Ahmed Nanupuri died of prolonged illness at Nanupur Madrassa under Fatkhahari thana here today. He was 92, reports BSS.

He left behind two sons and six daughters. His namaz-e-janaza will be held at Nanupur Madrassa premises after Zohr prayers tomorrow.

Dr Nilima Ibrahim chaired the function, while Prof Khan Sarwarumshid, Dr M A Wajed Mia, Prof Ajoy Roy, Prof Shahadat Ali and Rashid Haider took part in the discussion.

Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) organised a discussion meeting at the DU Club.

The meeting, presided over by DUTA president Prof M Mostafa Chowdhury, demanded arrest of the absconding killers of Bangabandhu.

A special prayer seeking the eternal peace of the souls of Bangabandhu and his family members as well as for peace, progress and prosperity of the nation was held at Sri Sri Dhakeshwari Temple in the city Friday evening.

The special prayer, organised by the Dhaka Mahanagar Puja Committee, was also attended by members of Kendriyo Puja Uddipan Parishad.

Communist Party of Bangladesh (CPB) paid homage to Bangabandhu in a meeting on Friday.

Mujahidul Islam Selim, general secretary of CPB, said the best way to remember Bangabandhu and honour him was to implement the progressive steps taken by him.

A discussion marking the day was held at Dhaka College on Friday.

Acting principal Prof Hosne Ara Akhter chaired the discussion.

Meanwhile, an art exhibition was inaugurated at Shipakala Academy Art Gallery in the city on Friday.

Artist Kazi Abdul Baset inaugurated the exhibition, organised by National Mourning Day Observance Committee of the Institute of Fine Arts.

About 200 art works on Bangabandhu are on display at the exhibition, which will remain open from 3 pm to 8 pm till August 21.

Chittagong

The national flag was lowered half-mast at all government and non-government offices buildings.
