





, nal goal drought when his team meet Northern Ireland in one of 14 European Zone World Cup qualifiers on Wednesday, reports Reuter.

The Germans will need to secure their first victory over Northern Ireland for 20 years if they are to keep in touch with Group Nine leaders Ukraine ahead of next month's tough game against Portugal.

The German skipper knows he is under pressure to score in Belfast but hopes the return from injury of midfielder Thomas Haessler will help.

"We didn't have a single chance on goal in Ukraine (in June when the teams drew 0-0). In that situation you can't do much as a striker," he said. "I missed Haessler with his creativity.'

Germany have a poor recent record against one of Europe's lesser footballing powers. They drew one all in Nuremberg in November, the third successive 1-1 draw between the two. Before that Northern Ireland won two games against the former West Germany and not since 1977 have the three times world champions managed a victory.

Portugal trail Germany on goal difference and will hope to change that situation when they host draw specialists Armenia. The former Soviets have drawn five of their six games.




