After being dismissed for 340 during the first test against India.

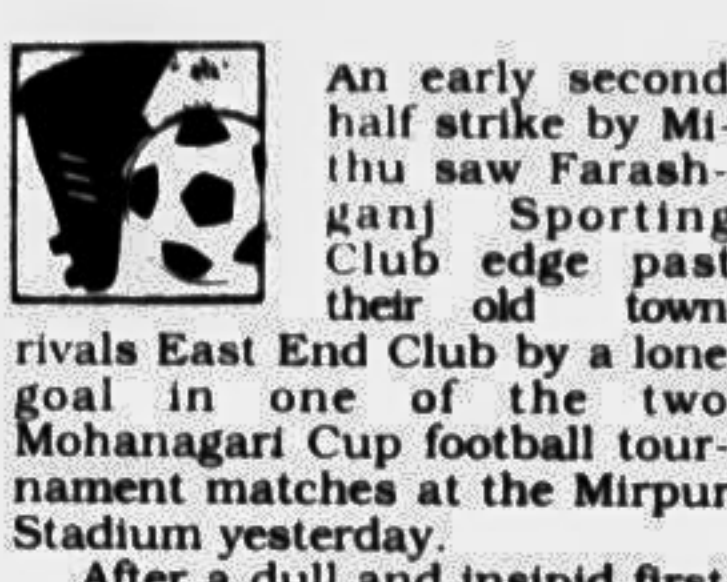

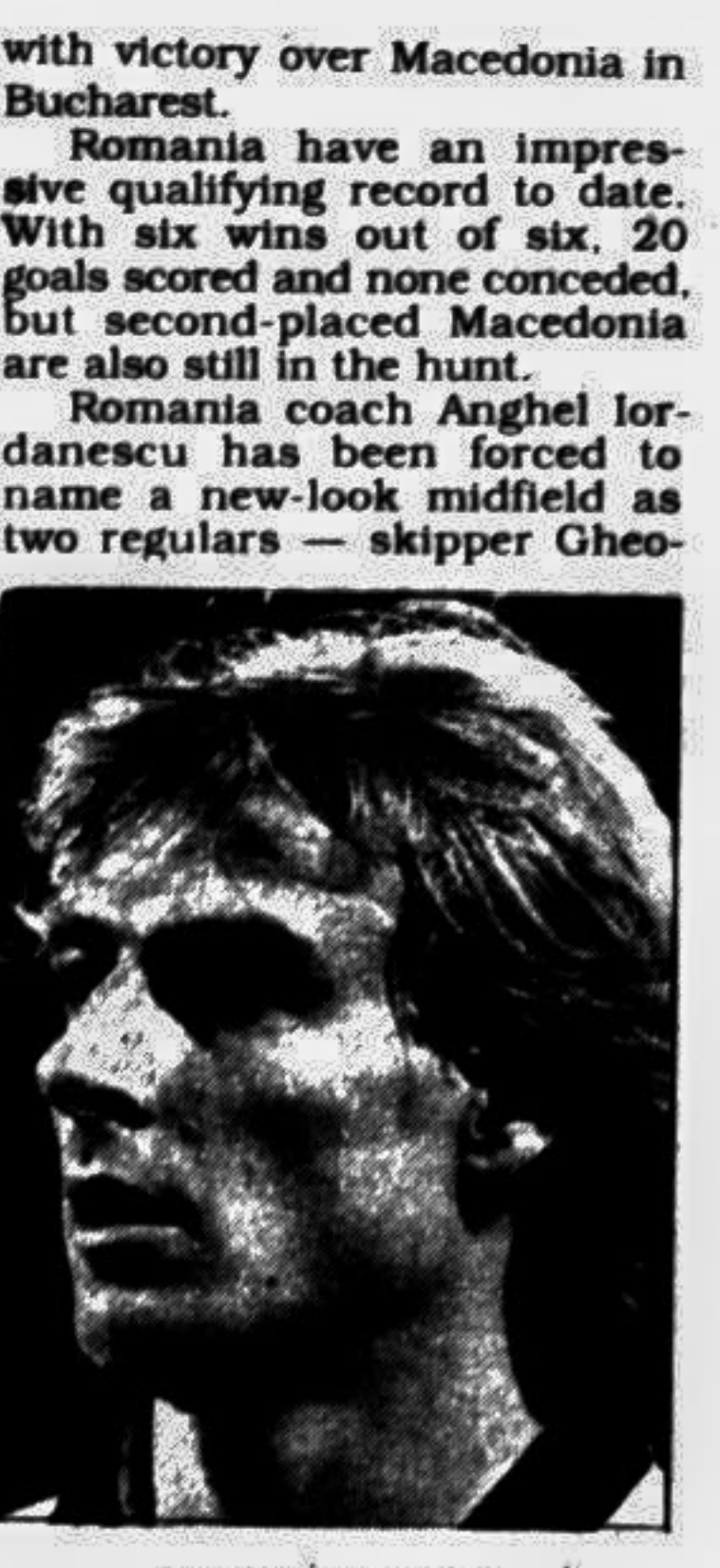

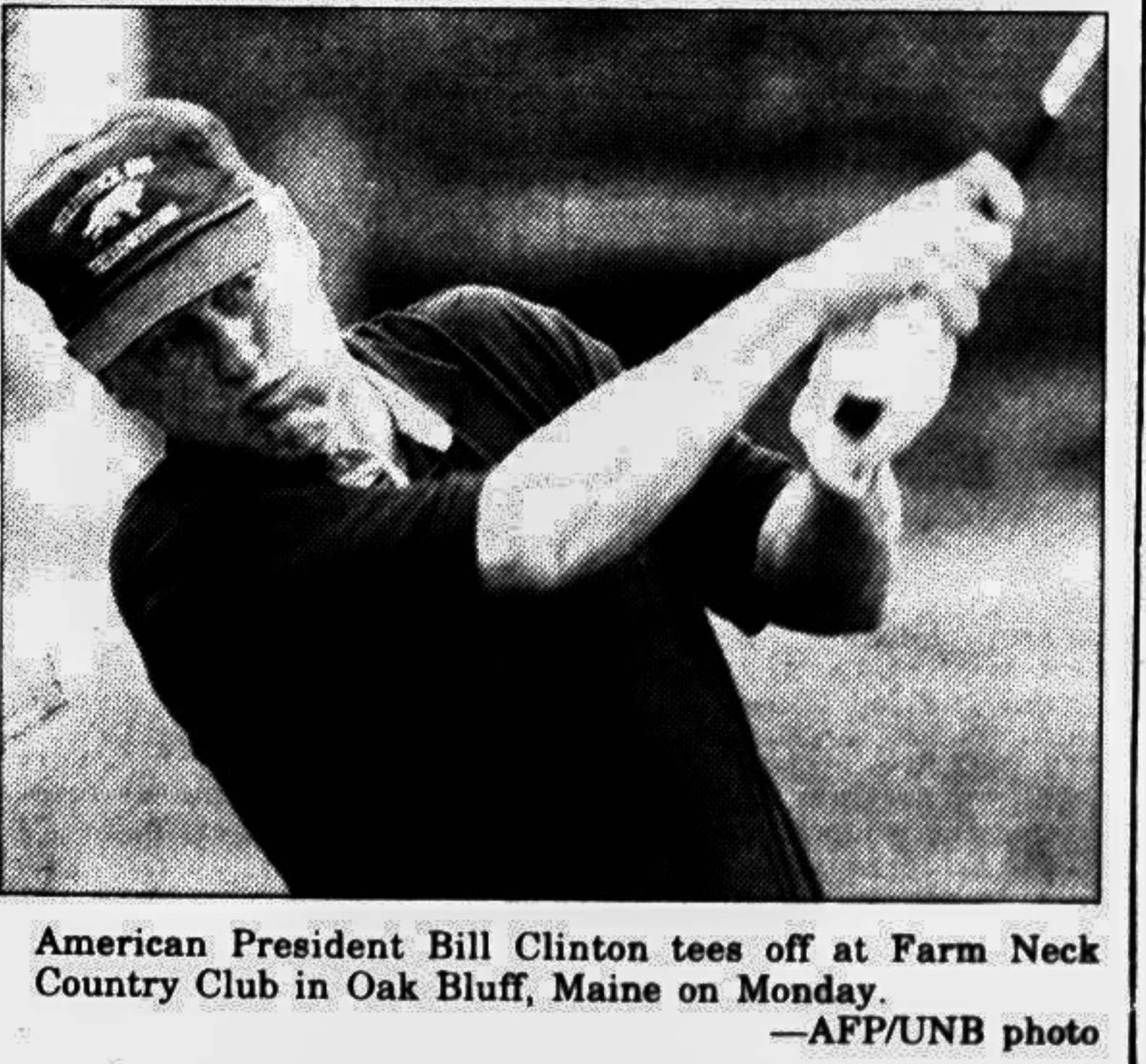
