

## Self Assessment System for **Private Limited Company**

In view of easy assessment of taxes, self assessment system has been introduced also for private limited companies with effect from 1997-98 tax year. From now on, if any private limited company-

(a) submits return showing income over minimum 10%

of the last assessed income and clears tax accordingly, or

(b) shows income ratio paying 10% of total paid up capital or 2.5% of total turnover as tax, then the return will be accepted as final by the Tax Department and without any question assessment of tax will be completed accepting the return income. However, in this case the minimum tax amount will be Tk 25,000/= (twently five thousand).

The income where it accrues more among the terms as described should be shown in the return and the tax should be cleared prior to submission of return. This being more easy & attractive in comparison with
