KCC prepares Tk 785 cr project for surface water treatment plant

KHULNA. Aug 27. Khulna City Corporation (KCC) has prepared a Taka 785 crore project for surface water treatment plant for supplying four crore gallons drinking water daily to the residents.

KCC sources told BSS that the project was yet to be approved by the government but the Australian government had shown interest in financing it. KCC is yet to develop a proper drinking water supply system and it badly needs one for its about fifteen lakh city dwellers.

KCC supplies fifty per cent of drinking water to Khulna metropolitan city on the basis of ground water base system. Twenty-five to thirty per cent drinking water of the city comes from unplanned private sources which are responsible for the fall in the underground water level, KCC sources added.

KCC has been trying to improve water supply system and

the World Bank conducted a survey in this connection recently.

Meanwhile, World Bank has accepted a Taka 90 crore drinking water supply and modernisation project for Khulna metropolitan city and the project styled Municipal Service Project (MSP) is at the final stage of approval of the government, KCC sources said. The project when implemented would meet the water supply need of the city.
