



## SAFF squad leaves today

## Booters vow to end jinx

The national football team leaves the capital this afternoon with a mission to fulfil a long-cherished dream of winning a regional football tourney, which has so far eluded the success-lorn nation.

But this time around in the South Asian Football Federation (SAFF) tourney, scheduled to begin in Kathmandu from September 4, Bangladesh will be desperately in need of a success for not only to end the long-standing jinx, but to provide the necessary shot in the arm of country's dwindling soccer.

"We are confident to win the Cup this time to fulfil our commitment to the nation", said Anjan Chowdhury Pinto, the chef-de-mission of the 24-member Bangladesh squad, in a press briefing, organised for the second time, at the Mirpur Stadium yesterday. The press conference, scheduled for Wednesday at the BFF office, could not be held due to the negligence of the BFF authorities.

Anjan, who is also a vice-president of BFF, however, expressed his apology about the

mix-up, said, "We need the trophy to revive the popularity of the noble game".

On the other hand, the German coach of the national team, Otto Pfister said that only a determined approach of his boys would bring the laurels for the nation.

This side is better than the one that finished runner-up to India in the Madras SAF Games. It is a technically a sound team and a blend of youth and experience. But our only handicap is the lack of determination to snatch glory", the blond-haired German, who inspired Bangladesh to lift the lone international trophy in Myanmar a couple of years back.

Tipped as perennial favourites among the seven SAARC member-nations, Bangladesh, however, had never won any event in their eight previous attempts including seven successive abortive bids in the SAF Games and a disappointing SAARC football tourney in Sri Lanka.

Captain Jewel Rana, who had also attended the crowded press briefing, had also expressed his optimism about winning the tourney.
