The minister said that there was no alternative to technical education for achieving national progress and as such, the government would continue to develop it in the greater national interest. He said, one of the three women's polytechnic institutes would be set up in Khulna. Work is going on at the Khulna airport project, he added.

He called upon the people to

extend their cooperation to the government in implementing development programmes.

Meanwhile, thirty-seven roads, culverts, pavements and embankments were constructed at a cost of Taka 20 crore and seventy-two lakh in Khulna. Bagerhat and Satkhira districts during the last financial year.

official sources said here today. The total expenditure included Tk four crore and seventy lakh as land acquisition money, cost of survey, construction of embankment and preparation of lay-out for Rupsa bridge at Labonchar near Khulna city.
