2 violators get life term

BARISAL, Sept 6: Badal and Zakir were sentenced to life imprisonment and fined Tk 5,000 each and in default to suffer more 2 years' rigorous imprisonment (RI) for raping a teenage girl, here on Wednesday.
 Araash Uddin, judge of the women and child repression control court here gave this verdict. The story in brief is, Badal and Zakir violated Abida Akhtar, a teenage girl, on November 11, 1996 at Gournadi thana headquarter of Barisal district. Abida was abducted on gun point when she was on way to Khulna from the Gournadi bus stand in the evening. Abida lodged a case against the two accused persons with Gournadi thana the next day. Examining 14 witnesses the judge gave this verdict.

Missing school girl yet to be traced

Some people rushed to the spot and recovered Hasibur after attempting for half an hour. They took him to Rajshahi Medical College Hospital (BMCH). Doctors on duty examined and declared him dead. The dead has been identified as a son of Abdul Karim of Mirjapur village.

BRDB disburses loan to coop members

 Police said a Dhaka-bound truck from Aricha ran over the unidentified youngman at about 10:30 am. The body was sent to Dhaka Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy. A case was filed.

2 minor girls drown

MADARIPUR, Sept 6: Two minor girls drowned in the beel at village Kharakandi under Shibchar thana recently, reports BSS.
 They were identified as Roqsana, 8, daughter of Kazi Khabiruddin and Josna, 7, daughter of Kazi Kohinur. The victims were collecting the lilies from the beel nearby their residences and suddenly drowned in beel water. Later, people recovered the bodies from the beel.

Touch stone statue recovered

KISHOREGANJ, Sept 6: Police recovered a stolen touch stone statue of Shiva on Monday from Kacharipara in Sadar thana and arrested two people in this connection, reports UNB.
 According to police, the precious 450 years old statue weighing 40 kg was stolen from the temple, made in the name of Chandrabati, on August 27 from Nilganj rail station in Kacharipara. Arrested Sabuj Mia and Mohammad Ali were produced before the court but the Magistrate sent them to jail *hajaj* after rejecting their bail prayers.

Stalemate at Kushtia College

 The college teachers are on strike for an indefinite period for assaulting the acting college Principal Provat Kumar Mani. A group of students compelled him to leave the college premises. They declared him unwanted person in the college.
 On September 1 afternoon the Honours final year examination was stopped as the students went out of the hall.
 Informed sources said, some students tried to assault some teachers because they were not allowed to copy in the examination hall. On September 2 at 10 in the morning the college teachers held an emergency meeting with Prof Abdur Rouf in the chair. The meeting reviewed the college situation.
 The meeting strongly condemned actions of a group of students.
 The meeting decided to continue an indefinite strike until restoration of congenial atmosphere on the college campus.
 Police forces have been deployed in the college premises to quell the situation.

Inqilab Editor, 2 others sued

Two cartoon Ashok Dhar said, badly damaged the credibility of the government which was also a threat to our sovereignty.
 Munshi Mohammad Shahabuddin, class one Magistrate of Jhenidah issued summons three accused persons under Section 292 and 504 under BPC.

45 hurt as AL, BNP clash in Ullapara

SIRAJGANJ, Sept 6: At least 45 people were injured, 10 critically, in a clash between the activists of ruling Awami League and opposition BNP in Ullapara thana recently reports UNB.
 Witnesses said the thana unit offices of both the rival parties were ransacked, several shops damaged and a meeting of Awami League was looted during the one and half an hour clash.
 Police lobbed tear gas shells and charged baton on the warring groups who turned the area into a warfield hurling bricks and exploding bombs.
 Witnesses said the clash erupted at about 6.15 pm.

National Killers of Arshad Ali yet to be nabbed

FARIDPUR, Sept 6: Killers of Arshad Ali Bepari, an octogenarian of village Tangle Khana under the Sadar thana are still at large.
 They are roaming about in the area fearlessly and threatening member of the deceased's family for withdrawing the murder case filed with Kotwali thana against 11 persons on July 3, the day of the murder.
 Arshad Ali Bepari was reportedly beaten to death at 5 pm on July 3 near the village market in presence of a good number of people.
 According to local people, there was an altercation between the deceased's grand son Yunus, 20, and a youth Farhad of his age of the same village over smoking bidi. At one stage they attacked each other. Later Farhad ran to his house and informed his family members of the incident. At this his family members rushed to the spot and found Arshad Ali there. All of them began to beat him with lathis and hockey sticks and fled away leaving him unconscious.
 Arshad Ali was immediately sent to Faridpur General Hospital where he succumbed after admission.
 The deceased's eldest son lodged a case with Kotwali thana on the same day accusing 11 persons. The accused persons are as follows: Farhad son of Shahed Ali, Mamon, son of Kuddus Khan, Majid son of Parashullah, Shahab Ali son of Parashullah, Allam son of Parashullah, Shahid, son of Shahab Ali, Shahidul son of Wajuddin Munshi, Kuddus Khan, son of Momtaj Khan, Hannan Khan, son of Momtaj Khan and Parashullah, son of Yad Ali. Matabbar — all of them belong to the village Tangle Khana. Some of the accused persons were allegedly involved in two other murder cases previously.

 Presided over by Raiganj TNO A K M Mohsin, the meeting was also attended by principal of the college Shamsul Haq, college teachers and police administration.
 The meeting also cancelled the preseted students' union of the college.
 Earlier, the pro-Awami League Chhatra League divided

 A case was filed with the police in this connection.
 Meanwhile, Bhutto group called indefinite strike at the college from Saturday protesting the filing of the panel by the AL leaders without consulting them.
 Police forces have been deployed in the college campus to avert any untoward incident.

Separate incidents claim 11

KISHOREGANJ, Sept 6: Eleven people were killed in separate incidents in six thanas of the district during last week, reports UNB.
 Police and hospital sources said six people of two families drowned when a country boat carrying them sank in Hooliarhaor in Tariat thana on Monday.
 The victims were Golap, 30, his wife Saedunnisa, 24, daughter Suenia, 2, sister-in-laws Nasima, 16, and Kalpana 26, and her two-year-old son Sakhawat.
 On the following day, a speeding truck ran over a rickshawpuller, Jasim Uddin, at Jafraabad village in Kulliarchar thana.
 A septuagenarian man, Yusuf Ali, was also crushed under the wheels of a bus on Kishoreganj-Mymensingh road at Ghoshpala in Nandail thana on the same day.
 Police said, also on the day, Tara Miah, 60, a mentally retarded man of Noapara village in Nikli thana, allegedly committed suicide by hanging himself. Besides, a 20-day-old boy was killed mysteriously at Kotiadi village.
 Earlier on Sunday, one Khurshid Alam, 28, allegedly committed suicide by taking poison at his house at Nagergaon village of Kotiadi.
