Truck Drivers and Workers Federation

Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzak yesterday laid stress on maintaining good relations among the owners, workers and employees of the transport sector to build a disciplined transport system, reported BBS.

Speaking as the chief guest at the inaugural of a two-day workshop entitled "Truck workers in the twenty-first century", organised by Bangladesh Truck Drivers and Workers Federation at a city hotel, the minister said the goal of the present government is to improve the lot of the common people.

Communications Minister Anwar Hossain was present on the occasion as special guest.

Presided over by president of the federation Mohammad Ismail, the function was addressed among others, by general secretary Ray Ramesh Babu, and general secretary of Bangladesh Truck Owners Association Rostam Ali Khan.

Razzak said road accidents are occurring everyday due to reckless driving, causing huge loss of lives and properties. He urged all concerned to abide by the traffic rules to help ensure safety of lives and properties.

Communications Minister asked all concerned to come forward to remove irregularities and indiscipline for the development of transport sector.

BGS, BCAS

Bangla-German Sampreeti (BGS) and Bangladesh Centre for Advanced Studies (BCAS) jointly organised a seminar on "Saving Forestry Resources by Popularising Unnata Chula" on Sep 4 at BGS conference room.

The competition is open to children worldwide, born on or after January 1, 1982.

Competitors are free to choose the theme/subject for their paintings/drawings/writings. Each entry should be certified by a parent/guardian/teacher that it is the original, unaided work of the competitor done during 1997. Entries should be an individual effort and not a combined work.

They confessed to the police that they were carrying the goods from Benapole border for some shops of Dhaka New Market and Gausia Market.



Two people were arrested along with Indian fabrics worth about Tk 8 lakh from Mirpur road in Dhanmondi thana on Saturday, reports UNB.

Acting on a tip-off, DB police intercepted a truck on the road after following it from Gabtali bus terminal and arrested its driver Abdul Hasan (45) and his helper Mohammed Ali Hossain (18) along with Indian sarees and garments materials.

They alleged that terrorism by Jamaat-Shibir axis plus destructive acts by Islami Oikya Jote and other hardliners were pushing the entire nation towards a disaster.

Addressing a workers rally at Mirpur in the city the committee leaders called for strengthening the grassroots-level movement initiated by late Jahanara Imam to "save the country from conspiracies by evil forces."

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The government has called for building up a vigorous movement against the Awami League government to protest its failure in all fronts, reports UNB.

The call was made at a three-day meeting of the party's central committee, that concluded in the city on Saturday, said a press release.

It said the government is completely dependent on the policies of World Bank-IMF, civil and military bureaucracy and NGOs.

The government has also miserably failed to restore law and order and ensure security of life and property of the common people. It is yet to repeal the Special Powers Act, Vested Property Act and other discriminatory laws, the WP pointed out.

The meeting said its fascist behaviour has been curbing the freedom of expression of the opponents and compromising with the communal forces.

It said Bangladesh has become the dumping ground and market of foreign goods in last 15 months as the Awami League government has been implementing the instructions of World Bank and IMF.
