No reason to enhance fuel price, says Saifur

Former Finance Minister Saifur Rahman Saturday said he didn't see a single logic behind the fuel price hike and termed the government as most insensitive to people's grievances, reports UNB.

The government's claim of loss for the increase in petroleum prices in the international market is 'totally distorted and manipulated'; he said at a discussion here in the evening.

"The decision to enhance the fuel price is based on the arrogance of the government. It is totally abuse of power...the government attitude is — I will do as I wish because I am in power."

"Even the amount allocated for the pay scale is not in the hand of government due to huge revenue shortfall," he added.

Turning to lodging of a large number of cases with the High Court regarding duty, the former minister said this happened as the government has given unlimited discretionary power to the customs house.


