#### Mosque on runway Commissioner of Ward 14 refutes allegation

Commissioner of Ward 14 in the city Abdul Kader has refuted allegation by the Military Estates Office (MEO) that he was backing a group of people who illegally built a mosque on Tej-

gaon old airport runway. A Daily Star report on September 6 said that a group of people built a mosque on the extreme northern side of the old airport runway. MEO officials alleged that the Ward Commissioner was backing the group.

Talking to The Daily Star. Kader said he was fighting to rid the area of illegal constructions. "The mosque people invited me to say prayers there but I refused because Allah will not accept prayers offered from an illegally occupied place. Kader said.

He alleged that 'unscrupulous MEO officials' were responsible for 'renting out' government lands in the same area for Tk 200 to 500 a month.

There are over 200 tin-shed houses rented by MEO officials. who realise rent every month," said the Ward Commissioner He also said Works Minister Mohammad Nasim had ordered an investigation into the matter but the investigation report only said that the land did not belong to his ministry.

"I want to take the matter to higher authorities because it is a case of complete lawlessness here," said Kader.

### Interpol confce in mid-Oct

#### Dhaka, Delhi may raise issue of non-execution of Red Alert notices

Inter-state fugitives issue will be the top of agenda when Interpol meets in its 66th annual conference in New Delhi in

mid-October, reports UNB. Bangladesh as well as neighbouring India will raise the issue as both the countries want to get back some persons charged with criminal offences under their respective laws.

The two countries will also raise their voice separately against non-execution of Interpol's Red Alert notices served against the persons, officials said in Dhaka.

A Red Alert Notice sent by the Interpol, requiring arrest of a criminal, is generally honoured by the Interpol member-

lating the report Speaking on the occasion Prof Shamsul Hug said that the committee has recommended a three-tier education system for primary, secondary and higher secondary levels. The committee has also suggested a uniform curricula for the primary level, change in the existing system of work-oriented curricula and training for teachers at all lev-

"The committee recommended inclusion of class I to class VIII in the primary level and class IX to class XII in the secondary level." Prof Shamsul Hug said.

The Committee has recommended that the eight-year primary level be introduced in phases by the year 2010 with necessary development of the infrastructure.

Three-year and four-year courses have been suggested for colleges and universities re-

spectively. Two-year and one-year Master's degree courses have been suggested for those having three-year and four-year graduation courses respectively. Twoyear M Phil course leading to three-year PhD has also been recommended by the commit-

Prof Shamsul Huq also said that the Committee has proposed modernisation of the madrassha education and enrolment of female students in madrassahas.

Shamsul Huq also said that the 58-member Committee formed 19 sub-committees and the members of the team also visited divisional headquarters and met educationists, politicians, students' leaders. The education minister said

that the committee was entrusted with the task of formulating a report on the basis of the Kudret-e-Khuda Education Commission Report.

Sadek also said that the government did not interfere in the work of the committee.

Maj (retd) Mohiuddin, Maj (retd) Rashed Chowdhury, Maj (retd) Ahmed Sharful Hasan, Capt (retd) Kismat, Capt (retd) Majed, Lt (retd) Nazmul Ansar, Risalder (retd) Moslemuddin Dafadar (retd) Marfat Ali Shah and Dafadar (retd) Abul Hashem Mridha.

titute and ill. Gujral, dressed in black, paid his homage at the St Thomas Church where the body of the 87-year-old Roman Catholic nun is kept for the thousands of mourners, wit-

nesses said. He was also accompanied by his wife, Sheila. Gujral said: "On behalf of the bereaved nation I have come here to pay tribute to Mother Teresa.

"She was a beacon of light and hope who removed the tears of suffering millions. We are fortunate that Mother Teresa started the Missionaries of Charity in this country." Gujral was joined by some

15,000 mourners who queued outside the Roman Catholic Church for a view of the Nobel Peace Prize winner. "We had Gandhiji in the first

half of the century to show us the path to fight poverty and in the second half we had Mother Teresa to show us the path to work of the poor," Gujral added. Gujral said millions felt orphaned because of the ailing

nun's death. "I am one of the orphans. I have come here to pray, to offer

my homage." US President Bill Clinton linked the two women — Teresa and Diana - in his weekly radio broadcast.

Princess Diana — two women of

"Mother Teresa and vastly different backgrounds and worlds - are gone, but each of them in her own way has shown us what it is to live a life of meaning through concern for others," Clinton said.

That is the great legacy they leave us. Let us honour it.' Mother Teresa's body was carried in a simple wooden coffin today from the Calcutta headquarters of her worldwide charity to a church where it will






