Int'l Literacy Day observed

Bangladesh with the rest of the world yesterday observed the International Literacy Day with a vow to attain 62 per cent literacy rate by the year 2000 and hundred per cent by 2005, reports BSS.

President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed inaugurated the nationwide programme of the day at a function at the Osmany Auditorium and distributed awards among the best teachers.

Primary and Mass Education Division and several government departments, NGOs and socio-cultural organisations have taken up different programmes to mark the day.

A grand procession of concerned government officials, NGOs and social workers was brought out in the city in the morning which was led by Deputy Minister for Primary and Mass Education Prof Zinnatunnesa Talukder. The parade started from the central Shaheed Minar and ended at Osmany Auditorium.

Cultural organisations and several theatre groups presented cultural functions, including songs and street drama, promoting literacy.

Deputy Minister for Primary and Mass Education Prof Zinnatunnesa Talukdar told the news agency that the current literacy rate in Bangladesh is 47.30 per cent against the world average of 23 per cent.

RAJSHAHI, Sept 8: International Literacy Day was observed in a befitting manner here today.

Mass literacy fair, discussion and cultural function were held to mark the occasion.

Speakers at a discussion held at local Loknath High School premises said that national progress was not possible without mass education. They stressed the need for making collective efforts of all, particularly the educated class to render their service to eradicate illiteracy from society for all-round development of the country.

Repeal of section 13(1) of Nat'l Drug Policy opposed

Bangladesh Pharmaceutical Society has opposed a demand placed by 'certain quarters' for repealing a section of the National Drug Policy that provides for compulsory supervision of drug manufacturing by registered pharmacists, reports UNB.

Section 13(1) of the National Drug Policy, which subsequently became a law for controlling drug manufacturing in the country, states: No person shall manufacture any drug except under the supervision of a pharmacist registered in Register 'A' of the Pharmacy Council of Bangladesh.

At a press conference held at the Jatiya Press Club yesterday, Society general secretary Mujib Khan described the demand as a design to destroy the country's pharmaceutical industry, which, he said, is about to achieve self-sufficiency in meeting domestic medicine requirement.

Giving a brief account of the steady growth in the drug industry, he said in 1996, the country's drug-manufacturing industries produced medicine worth about Tk 1600 crore. Bangladesh is now in a position to export pharmaceutical products to about 20 countries including Germany, Ukraine, Russia, Singapore, South Africa, Thailand, the Philippines, Indonesia, Myanmar, Syria, Iran, Yemen, Zimbabwe, Kenya, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, Malawi, Nepal, Vietnam and Bhutan.

Besides, Bangladesh exports some pharmaceutical raw materials.

Pro-Awami League Chhatra League has called for a united movement against Islami Chhatra Shibir to resist their terrorist activities in educational institutions, reports UNB.

The call was given at a rally held in front of Modhu's Canteen on the Dhaka University campus yesterday morning, protesting the 'terrorist activities' by Shibir in Chittagong and Rajshahi universities.

Addressing the rally, BCL leaders alleged that the Shibirites, backed by Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal, are carrying out violence on the university campuses.

They also urged the countrymen to check Jamaat-Shibir axis from doing politics in the name of religion.

BCL president Enamul Haq Shamim and general secretary Ishaq Ali Khan Panna and its leaders Bahadur Bepari and Abdul Wadud Khokon addressed the rally.

JCD demands resignation of DU Proctor

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal has demanded immediate resignation of the Dhaka University Proctor, Dr A K M Nur-un-Nabi, for his 'failure' in protecting JCD activists from the attack at Ziaur Rahman Hall last month, reports UNB.

JCD leaders reiterated their demand at a rally at Aparajeya Bangla on the campus yesterday. It was arranged to protest the various steps undertaken by the university authorities in the name of curbing campus violence.

The DU authorities, by using the tactics of evacuating dormitories, were rehabilitating the outsiders of Awami League-backed Chhatra League, said JCD president Shahiduddin Chowdhury Annie.

'It is nothing but a blueprint of the Awami League government to eliminate JCD from the campus,' he added.
