Sima's death Nari Samaj rejects parliamentary body report

Sammilita Nari Samaj has rejected the report of the parliamentary committee on the death of Sima Chowdhury.

The leaders of Nari Samaj, at a press conference in the city yesterday, alleged that the investigation of the parliamentary committee was completely faulty.

The Nari Samaj leaders demanded fresh enquiry into the rape of Sima Chowdhury and the cause of her death in jail subsequently. They also called for exemplary punishment of those involved in the incidents.

Nari Samaj urged the Home Ministry to grant leave for a case to be lodged against the investigating officer of the Sima Chowdhury case.

The Samaj leaders urged the government to take necessary steps so that the report and the suggestions made in it does not affect the case in any way.

The press conference was addressed, among others, by Sultana Aktar Rubi, Sigma Huda, Farida Aktar, Maleka Begum, Shaheen Anam, Habibunnesa and Dilwara Aktar Jahan.

Awami League General Secretary and LGRD and Co-operative Minister Zillur Rahman will return home today after a three-day official visit to Indonesia, reports UNB.

During his stay in Jakarta, Zillur Rahman attended a regional conference on 'Poverty Alleviation and Sharing of Experiences' there.

The Bangladesh minister presented the country paper titled 'Poverty Alleviation and the Role of Local Government Structures' at the conference, sponsored by the United Nations Development Programme.

Delegates and representatives from 14 Asian countries attended the conference and shared their experiences to combat hunger, malnutrition and strategies to develop sustainable rural life improvement.

Youngman succumbs to injury

A youngman, who was injured in a clash at Shaheenbagh in the city nearly three weeks back, died at his house yesterday, reports UNB.

Police said Nazmul Huda (25) was injured in a clash at Hindu colony in the area on Aug 15. He was admitted to a hospital and later released after treatment.

Family members of the victim told the police that the youngman succumbed to his wounds at his house at Civil Aviation slum.

A case was filed with Tejgaon thana in this connection. The body was sent to Dhaka Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Donation to PM's relief fund

United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) has donated US dollars 50,000 to the Prime Minister's Relief Fund, reports UNB.

Foreign Minister Abdus Samad Azad received a cheque for the amount from UNESCO Director in Bangladesh Ansar Ali Khan at state guest house Padma yesterday.

Tozammel Huq, senior consultant of the UNESCO Director General, was also present on the occasion.

The UNESCO officials apprised the Foreign Minister of the activities of the UN organisation in Bangladesh.

They also exchanged views on possible UNESCO assistance for the development of formal and non-formal primary education programme in Bangladesh in future.

SKOP Dhaka div convention Sept 12

Leaders of the Sramik Karmachari Oikya Parishad (SKOP), a conglomerate of workers and employees' bodies, in a meeting Monday demanded of the government not to denationalise any industry without consulting them.

Chaired by workers' leader Abdus Salam Khan, the meeting discussed the Cabinet decision regarding disinvestment of five state-owned industries, says a press release.

It also decided to hold a convention of SKOP representatives from Dhaka division on September 12 at Jatiya Press Club auditorium at 3 pm.

The meeting expressed deep concern at the recent fire-fueled stampede at garment factories where five workers were killed, saying the gates of the factories were under lock and key. About one hundred garments workers died in similar incidents so far, the meeting observed.

The SKOP leaders demanded legal actions against the factory owners who are responsible for death of garments workers and that their families be given compensation.

SKOP leaders Abul Bashar, Md Nurul Islam, Mesbahuddin Ahmed, Dr Wajedul Islam Khan, Iqbal Majumder, Omar Faruk Khairu, Shah Alam and Abdul Wahed were present at the meeting.

Efforts on to alleviate poverty: Sajeda

Minister for Environment and Forest Syeda Sajeda Chowdhury said that Bangladesh is continuing its efforts for attaining sustainable development including alleviation of regional poverty along with other SAARC countries, according to an official hand-out received here yesterday, reports BSS.

"The government will also implement all international agreements and protocols on protection of environment signed after the Earth Summit in 1992," she told an international conference that concluded on Monday at the Koba city of Japan.

The two-day Eco-Conference '97 on protection and taking initiatives to continue sustainable development for Asia and the Pacific region begun on Sunday. It was inaugurated by Minister for Global Environmental Affairs of Japan Ms Michiko Ishii.

Narrating the gravity of global changes in climate including that of Bangladesh the minister said 17.5 per cent of Bangladesh's land would submerge under the sea in future due to expansion of sea surface water level. The minister is expected to return home on September 11.
