Shoot the Kids




THE CULTURAL


## STAR PLUS' HOMAGE TO MOTHER TERESA

Star Plus pays homage to Mother Teresa with a special programme 'All In God's Love' — a Tribute to Mother Teresa on Friday, September 12 at 9 pm.

This half an hour documentary covers all aspects of the life and works of the Nobel laureate. This special feature has been produced by Abhijit Das Gupta whose association with Mother Teresa began in 1972 and has since become one of the privileged few who covered Mother and her works, for various television programmes. The one and only time that the great humanitarian entered a television studio was in 1975, to appear in a television interview produced by Abhijit Das Gupta. 'All In God's Love' traces the origin of the Missionaries of Charity and features Mr. and Mrs. Michael Gomes, the couple who gave shelter to Mother Teresa when she first reached Calcutta. It was there that the foundation for Missionaries of Charity was laid.

The programme also shows an extraordinary interview with the Mother where she talks about her various achievements and her charity homes — Nirmal Hriday, Prem Dan and Shisu Bhavan, along with comments from Father Edward Lejoy, the official biographer to Mother Teresa. On Saturday, from 9:30am Star Plus will bring viewers the live coverage of Mother Teresa's funeral from Calcutta. This programme will follow the funeral procession of the Mother from St. Thomas' church to Netaji stadium for a special mass. Interspersed in between the funeral coverage will be interviews with Raghu Rai and Navin Chawla, photographic biographers of Mother Teresa and tributes to the Saint from the street children and destitutes of Calcutta.
