20 lakh diabetic patients in the country

Speakers at a function in the city yesterday said the number of diabetic patients in the country would hit 40 lakh in the next 15 years owing to various socio-economic problems, reports UNB.

At present, there are about 20 lakh diabetic patients, the speakers said at the Dr Mohammad Ibrahim Memorial Lecture and Gold Medal-awar-

ding ceremony.

The Bangladesh Diabetic Samity organised the function in observance of the 8th death anniversary of Dr Mohammad Ibrahim, the founder of the Samity, at the BIRDEM auditorium yesterday.

To face 50 per cent of the alarming cases of diabetes, a diabetic hospital in each district and three more institutions like the BIRDEM should be set up in the capital, the speakers observed.

Speaking as chief guest, LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Zillur Rahman said, "We have to take a fresh pledge to materialise the ideals of Dr Ibrahim dedicated to the down-trodden and suffering people".

He said the government had given a Tk 10-crore grant for the cardiac centre of BIRDEM.

Seeking cooperation from all sections of society, the minister said the government was actively considering setting up one diabetic hospital in each district.

Later, Zillur Rahman presented the Dr Mohammad Ibrahim Memorial Gold Medal to the Kumudini Welfare Trust, established by eminent social worker Ranada Prasad Saha.

Reason behind alleged suicide of 2 sisters yet to be known

The reason behind the alleged suicide of two sisters together at a house of Indira Road in the city on Thursday was yet to be known, police said Thursday night.

Tejgaon police seized some 'fine crystals of an unknown substance' in a small polythene packet kept on a table in the room of the two young sisters.

The salt like stuff was also found on the floor of the attached bathroom where the bodies of the two were seen lying. Police said they sent the seized substance to the government chemical testing laboratory.

A senior police official said they were convinced that the sisters committed suicide. They were however, waiting for the autopsy report.

The bodies of two sisters — Fatema Nizami Chowdhury alias Sunny, 22, and Sharifa Nizami Chowdhury alias Jenni, 20, were recovered by police from inside the bathroom at about 11 am.

Police said Sunny was a student of ICMA and Jenni completed her HSC this year. The two resided with their sister's family.

Police thought that the incident was linked with love affairs.

The brother-in-law of the two sisters filed an unnatural death case with Tejgaon thana.

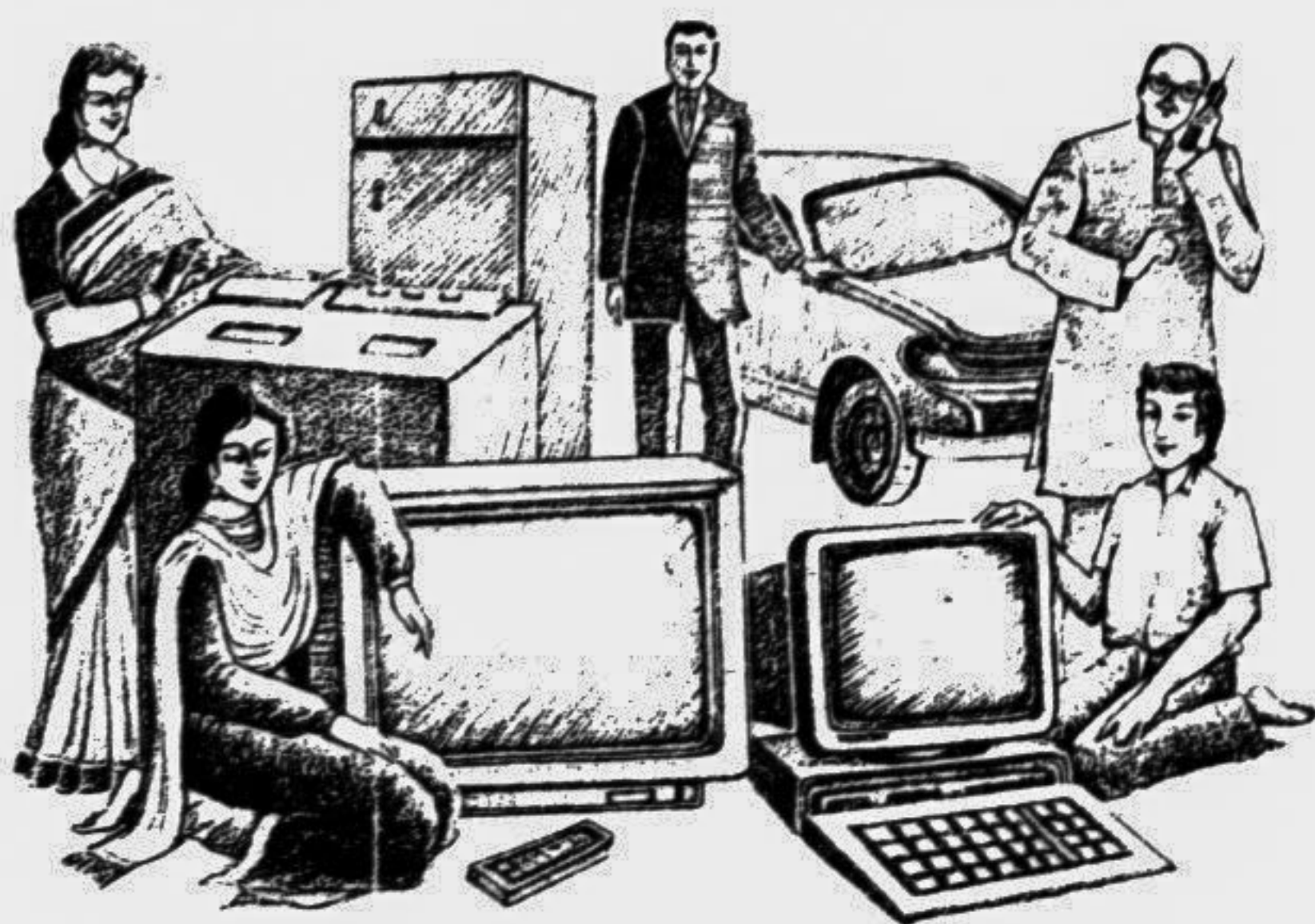
