Father's killer gets life term

SYLHET, Sept 13: The District and Sessions Judge of Nabiganj, Saheuddin Mahmud recently sentenced one person to suffer life term imprisonment on charge of killing his father. The prosecution case in brief is that Janab Ali of village Richi under Nabiganj sadar thana hit his father Suruj Ali with a piece of wood in the afternoon of February 12 of 1996 after an exchange of hot words over some family feuds. Suruj Ali was immediately rushed to the sadar hospital where he succumbed to his wounds. Another son of Suruj Ali filed a case with the police. The investigating police officer submitted chargesheet against the accused Janab Ali. The court after examining all the records and witnesses found the accused guilty and passed the judgement.

Touchstone statue recovered

RAJSHAHI, Sept 13: Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) 35 Battalion personnel recovered an idol recently. BDR sources claimed that the idol was made of touchstone worth about Tk 10 lakh. The idol was trafficked to India. On a secret information, BDR personnel carried search in a Chapainawabganj bound minibus Raju Paribahan at the Gourahanga Railgate in the city and recovered the idol. But nobody was arrested. A case was filed in this connection.

Kamdia College Principal robbed

GAIBANDHA, Sept 13: Principal of local Kamdia College under Gobindaganj thana was assaulted by some miscreants. They also snatched away Taka 9000 from him near Kamdia bazar recently.

Mizanur Rahman Chowdhury, Principal of college was returning home by his motorcycle in the afternoon. When he reached Kamdia bazar, a gang of miscreants intercepted him and claimed tolls. When he refused to offer any toll, the miscreants started beating mercilessly. They snatched away Taka 9000 at the sharp weapons points. Local people intervened, but the miscreants fled away. A case was filed with Gobindaganj thana.

Rangpur AL leader robbed

RANGPUR, Sept 13: Siddique Hossain, an ex-member of parliament (MP) of Rangpur and a member of the central Awami League Working Committee was robbed of valuable goods and cash amount worth Taka 70,000 recently.

According to the allegation, the Awami League leader now residing in Dhaka was rushing towards Hatibandha thana under Lalmonirhat district by a microbus. He was accompanied with his wife and other family members. But on the way at about 4:30 am when they crossed Paglapur under Rangpur sadar thana, some armed miscreants attacked them and at gun point they looted away cash money, ornaments and other valuable goods worth Taka 70,000. During retreat the miscreants damaged the microbus. A case has also been lodged with the Kotwali thana.

Memo handed over to Meherpur DC

MEHERPUR, Sept 13: Meherpur Zilla Unnayan Parishad has demanded immediate implementation of their 5-point demands including changing the name of the district to Mujibnagar with a view to commemorating the 9-month long Liberation War through which Bangladesh achieved its independence.

Mujibnagar was the first capital of Bangladesh while its provisional government was installed in exile. A memorandum containing their demands has been handed over to Deputy Commissioner, Meherpur for onward transmission of the same to the Prime Minister. The demands include: change of the name of the district, implementation of the declaration of the National Board of Revenue, establish a full-fledged Agricultural University at Chitla Agricultural Farm of Gangni thana, creating one more thana comprising Ratanpur of sadar thana and Bamundi of Gangni thana and nationalisation of Dariapur Mujibnagar Degree College and Gangni Degree College.

But he could not relish the glory of his good performance. Because Rozen, son of Golam Nabil, a veteran Freedom Fighter drowned in a pond at his grand father's house at Bakerganj on July 26 last.

His untimely death is not only a tragedy for his parents but also an irreparable loss for the whole nation.

Unsuccessful HSC candidate found dead

SHERPUR, Sept 13: A female student was found dead in the town Friday after she failed for the third time in this year's HSC examination, police and family members said, reports UNB.

Shahnaz Parveen, 20, a candidate from Sherpur Government Mohila College, went out of her residence on Thursday afternoon to know the result. But she remained missing failing to come out successful in the examination.

Students of the Mohila College Hospital saw the body of Shahnaz floating on water in the nearby pond this morning. Police recovered the body and sent it to the hospital morgue for autopsy.

Shahnaz was the daughter of Mozammel Huq, an Agrami Bank officer, of Bagraksha poura area.

30 pry schools of Razoir need renovation

MADARIPUR, Sept 13: Some 30 primary school buildings of Razoir thana have become unfit for academic activities, local guardians said, reports UNB.

The dilapidated schools are located in Durgabardee, Daserchar, Nayakandi, Kasimpur, Laxmipur, Char Mostafapur, Purba Nagardi and Sree Krishnadi.

The doors and walls of those schools are in a dilapidated condition and classes are being held with utmost risk during the rainy season.

Besides, students and teachers of 18 semi-pucca school buildings and five tin-shed structures face similar situation.

Local leaders have urged the authorities to take steps for immediate renovation of those schools.

'Bangladesh, a shining example of communal harmony'

PABNA, Sept 13: Post, Telecommunications, Housing and Works Minister Mohammad Nasim called upon all irrespective of party affiliations to strengthen the tie of amity, fraternity and unity to maintain communal harmony in the country, reports UNB.

Nasim also visited the Hemayetpur Mental Hospital. He went round different wards of the hospital and talked to the patients.

Later, the minister attended two separate receptions arranged in his honour at Sree Sree Anukul Chandra Tapaban High School and Pabna Municipality. Chairman of the Municipality accompanied the minister.

Cyclone shelter to be established at Diar Kadirpur

RAJBARI, Sept 13: The government will establish a cyclone centre at Diar Kadirpur char in Bagha thana of the district soon, reports UNB.

State Minister for Disaster Management and Relief Talukder Abdul Khaleque said this on Friday while visiting various areas affected by erosion of Padma river.

At least 700 dwelling houses of Kadirpur char and Kalidas Ghalhi char have been eroded in the river Padma and standing crops on 200 acres damaged.

The state minister assured the victims of Diar Kadirpur char to provide them with 200 VGF cards.

The minister was accompanied by Deputy Minister for Primary and Mass Education Prof Zinnatun Nesa Talukder, Tajul Islam, M Farook, district AL president Rakhal Chandra Das and organising secretary Anil Kumar Sarkar.

Survey report from Chouddagram, Comilla Sadar

Flash flood destroys crops on 10,000 acres of land each year

COMILLA, Sept 13: Flash flood and onrush of hilly waters every year destroy huge quantity of standing crops on 10,000 acres of marshy land of Daul Samudra in Sadar and Chouddagram thanas of the district, reports UNB.

According to a survey conducted by a social welfare organisation, some three lakh poor farmers of 22 villages of Kashinagar and Uzirpur unions in Chouddagram thana and eight villages of Pashchim Jorkaran union in Sadar thana

have been losing their crops for the last 38 years.

The affected villages are Satbaria, Balimuri, Dakshin Balimuri, Ramchandrapur, Uttar Jatrapur, Alipur, Jugirkandi, Mahadevpur, Joymongolpur, Pashchim Mahapur, Shibpur, Zilat, Bishnupur and Purba Mahapur of Kashinagar union and Islampur, Santoshpur, Rajapur, Samukshar, Kalikapur and Daul Samudra of Uzirpur union.

The affected villages of Jorkaran union in Sadar thana are Daribot, Padpurabot, Mojilishpur, Jagmohanpur, Harimchar, Hossainpur, Sultapur and Murad Kalapur.

The hilly waters from bordering Udaypur area inundate the low-lying areas while flowing into the Dakatia river through Daul Samudra destroying boro crops on 4,000 acres of land. Aman crops also cannot be cultivated on the land during the season.

Poor and marginal farmers of the low-lying Daul Samudra area urged the authorities concerned to take immediate measures to build an embankment on the bank of Boaljuri river.
