During the current fiscal, the Poura authority allocated Taka four lakh to kill mosquitoes and prevent their spreading. However, this programme is yet to start and is likely to begin in November next, the authoritative sources informed.

Meanwhile, the authorities fear, they might not be able to continue the eradication programme for more than one month with the allocated fund due to increased price of insec-

The authorities cover an area of 10.35 square miles to spray with the insecticide called "neucydle-60" which is imported. This chemical is effective", says an official Firmely spraying can halt growth of mosquito in young stage resulting in efficient con-

trol of the growth of mosquitoes". However, the Poura authority has purchased eight hand

spray machines and anti-

mosquito chemical - Mortein - which is specially for adult stage and less effective, according to an expert. So, he said mosquito control programme in the town area has been suffering a serious set back. Official sources said that an Anti-Mosquito Scheme was

launched in 1962-63 with 75 staff members which continued till 1980. Later, non-availability of government fund had forced the authority to limit its functions. Besides, a few of the staff members were transferred to various organisations which led to the closure of the department in 1990. A fresh anti-mosquito

scheme was submitted to the government several years back, but its is yet to be approved, the source informed. At present, the lone medical

officer of the municipality, who also responsible for mosquito control drive, is making fittle, progress, There is none to assist him.

A mosquito has a very short

life span — only 30 days. They live for 15 days as larva, the young stage and the rest of the 15 days as adult, the active stage, experts said.
