



#### \$2.5m budget recommended for '97-'98'

The 22nd meeting of the gov-erning board of Islamic Institute of Technology (IIT), a subsidiary organ of the Organisation of the Islamic Conference (OIC), was inaugurated by Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina on Wednesday at the IIT campus in Gazipur, says a press release.

The working session of the governing board began at a city hotel Thursday The first ses-sion was attended by representatives from Bangladesh, Egypt Indonesia, Malaysia, Morocco, Pakistan, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, representative of the Secretary General of the OIC Ambassador Ibrahim Ahmed, and Asstt.
